2005 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: April 25, 2005



UPCOMING MATCHES: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (20-2) is awaiting word on the upcoming 2005 NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament. SCSU is expected to receive its fifth consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bid, and is also a top candidate to host a first-round tournament. If the Huskies are selected for tournament play, the Regionals are slated to be played on May 6-7. As a potential one- or two-seed in the regional, SCSU could receive an NCAA host bid. If the Huskies host a first-round Regional Tournament, the four-team regional tournament would be played outdoors (most likely at the South Junior High School tennis complex in St. Cloud.) In case of rain on those days, the tournament would move indoors to the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in nearby Sartell.

ANOTHER YEAR, ANOTHER TITLE: SCSU gained its fourth consecutive NCC team title and 12th overall conference crown at the 2005 North Central Conference championships on April 21-22 at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell. SCSU posted 35 points to claim top honors, while Winona State was second at 25, Augustana was third at 16 and Minnesota State, Mankato was fourth at 14. At first singles, Tony Larson posted a 2-0 record and beat Winona's Gage Davidson 6-1, 6-2 in the title match. At second singles, Titus Christianson gained a 6-0, 6-2 win in his title match over Andrew Krueger of Augustana. At third singles, SCSU's Mike Engdahl chalked up a 6-3, 6-2 win over Augustana's Eric Olson. In play at fourth singles, Travis Marohl rolled to a 6-3, 6-3 win over Will Nagel of Winona. SCSU's Joey Jachymowski completed the title run with a 1-6, 6-2, 10-6 win over Kyle Savekoul of Winona in the fifth place bout. At sixth singles, Dan Boulay placed second for SCSU with a 1-1 record. At first doubles, Larson and Jachymowski won top honors with an 8-4 win over Davidson and Josh Malwitz of Winona. Christianson and Jeff Horner marked a conference crown at second doubles with an 8-5 win, and Boulay and Engdahl won their title match at third doubles by an 8-4 tally.



COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State men's tennis coach Jerry Anderson begins his 8th season with the Huskies in 2005. Anderson's teams have won NCC titles in 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. Anderson owns a career record at SCSU of 141-60. Of note, the Huskies have gained four consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bids under the leadership of Coach Anderson (2004, 2003, 2002 and 2001). A member of the St. Cloud State University tennis team from 1982-1984, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior campaign in 1984. He graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in physical education, a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. He also serves as the junior varsity girls' tennis coach at Monticello High School and served as the boys' and girls' junior varsity tennis coach at Anoka Senior High School from 1993 to 1995. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.

TEAM NOTES: SCSU is also ranked #2 in the latest NCAA Division II North Central Region poll, which was on April 20. This poll is important since it will determine which teams advance to the NCAA postseason tournament...SCSU has gained four consecutive NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004 ...SCSU's 12 NCC titles represent the most NCC crowns won by any team in any sport at SCSU...Titus Christianson has won three consecutive NCC titles at #2 singles for the Huskies, and two consecutive NCC titles at #2 double...SCSU has more NCC titles than any other conference school (past or present NCC member). Northern Colorado, Augustana and North Dakota have all won 10 NCC titles, while SCSU has won 12 since 1986 - including six crowns since 1997.
