2005 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: April 4, 2005



UPCOMING MATCHES: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (16-1) will battle nearby rival St. John's University on Tuesday, April 5. The match will be held at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex and the start time is slated for 4 p.m. On April 8, the Huskies will then host Augustana College at 11 a.m. and South Dakota State at 2 p.m. Both matches will be played at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell. Of note, the Augustana match is a make-up from a match postponed on March 20.

HUSKIES CRUSH CARLETON: In non-conference men's tennis play on Friday, April 1, St. Cloud State posted a 7-2 win over Carleton at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell. Tony Larson scored a 6-0, 6-2 win at #1 singles, while Titus Christianson tallied a 6-0, 6-2 win at #2 singles. Michael Engdahl won a match at #3 singles and Joey Jachymowski rolled to a win at #5 singles. In doubles action, Larson and Jachymowski won at #1 doubles, and Christianson and Jeff Horner won an 8-3 scored at #2 doubles. To complete the day, Engdahl and Travis Marohl won 8-4 at #3 doubles.

TEAM NOTES: In the latest Division II regional poll released by the ITA, the Huskies were ranked 3rd among North Central Region teams (up from #7). Titus Christianson was ranked 7th in the poll for singles (up from 13th) and Tony Larson gained a fifth place ranking in the region's latest singles poll. In doubles, Larson and Jachymowski are ranked fourth in the latest region poll...Titus Christianson is still undefeated in singles play at 17-0, while Tony Larson is 16-1 and frosh Michael Engdahl is 15-2...in doubles play, SCSU's Larson and Jachymowski are 13-3, while Christianson and Horner are 13-2 ...Larson is a transfer from NAIA school Westmont College (Santa Barbara, Calif.). A resident of Long Prairie, Larson played two seasons at Westmont and was nationally ranked in top 50 as a sophomore...the Huskies won the NCC title in 2004, and they also won every singles and doubles title at the NCC tournament last spring...SCSU will host the 2005 NCC championships at Gold's Gym on April 21-22...SCSU has gained four consecutive NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003 and 2004 ...SCSU's 11 NCC titles represent the most NCC crowns won by any team in any sport at SCSU...Titus Christianson won a NCC title at #2 doubles and #2 singles in 2004, while Jeff Horner won a title at #3 doubles.

COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State men's tennis coach Jerry Anderson begins his 8th season with the Huskies in 2005. Anderson's teams have won NCC titles in 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003 and 2004. Anderson owns a career record at SCSU of 137-59. Of note, the Huskies have gained four consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bids under the leadership of Coach Anderson (2004, 2003, 2002 and 2001). A member of the St. Cloud State University tennis team from 1982-1984, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior campaign in 1984. He graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in physical education, a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. He also serves as the junior varsity girls' tennis coach at Monticello High School and served as the boys' and girls' junior varsity tennis coach at Anoka Senior High School from 1993 to 1995. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
