HUSKIES WHIP WINONA, AUGUSTANA: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (9-2) charted an important regional and NCC win over Winona State by the score of 9-0 on Feb. 24. At #1 singles, Wojciech Batorski of SCSU beat Kyle Savekoul 6-2, 6-1. At #2 singles, SCSU's Mike Master charted a 6-1, 6-4 win over Aaron Lentz, while Joey Jachymowski posted a 6-2, 6-2 win at #3 singles for the Huskies. Kevin Lukens kept the ball rolling with a 6-7, 7-6, 1-0 (11-9) win at #4 singles and Tom Ronning won 7-5, 6-0 at #5 singles. To complete the singles sweep, Kris Johnson gained a 6-2, 5-7, 1-0 (13-11) win over Scott Hessian of Winona. In doubles play, Batorski and Master won 8-6 at #1 doubles, and Jachymowski and Ronning rolled to an 8-3 win at #2 doubles. To finish the day, Lukens and Johnson cruised to a quick 8-1 win at #3 doubles... the St. Cloud State men's tennis team (8-2) charted a 9-0 win over NCC rival Augustana College on Feb. 23, at the Gold's Gym Tennis Center in nearby Sartell. Wojciech Batorski gained a 6-1, 6-1 win over Eric Olsen for the Huskies at #1 singles. At #2 singles, Mike Master posted a 6-2, 6-4 win over Ryahn Gardner, while Joey Jachymowski rolled to a 6-0, 6-0 win at #3 singles for SCSU. The Huskies' Kevin Lukens gained a 6-1, 6-1 win at #4 singles and Tom Ronning won 6-2, 6-0 at #5 singles. To complete the singles run, SCSU's Kris Johnson won 6-2, 6-0 at #6 singles. In doubles play, Batorski and Master won 8-4 at #1 singles. Jachymowski and Ronning charted an 8-3 win at #2 doubles and Lukens and Johnson rolled to a 6-2, 6-0 win at #3 doubles.

TEAM NOTES: SCSU's matches against Minnesota Morris and Minnesota State Mankato were both postponed due to the recent snow storm. The teams are currently working on setting up make-up dates for these matches...13 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won five consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006...the Huskies return NCC champions Kevin Lukens (6th singles and third doubles), Kris Johnson (third doubles) and Joey Jachymowski (1st doubles and 4th singles)...the Huskies have won 18-or-more matches for the past six consecutive seasons - including 20 win seasons in 2006, 2005, 2002 and 2001...Wojciech Batorski was an Alabama state junior college champion at singles and doubles in 2006, while playing for Central Alabama Community College..Mike Master and Kris Johnson are both 9-1 in singles play this season, while the doubles team of Joey Jachymowski and Tom Ronning are unblemished at 5-0.



COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 10th season with the Huskies in 2007. Anderson owns a 172-68 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
