2007 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

HUSKIES CONTINUE HOME STAND: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team, the 13-time North Central Conference champions, will host Luther College (Noon) and Michigan Tech (7 p.m.) on Saturday, February 10 at the Gold's Gym Tennis Center in nearby Sartell. Admission for both of these tennis matches is free. Gold's Gym is located at 850 Pine Cone Road in Sartell, Minn.

SEASON OPENERS: The St. Cloud State University men's tennis team (2-0) opened its 2007 season on Feb. 2, with a pair of dual match victories at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell. SCSU posted a 6-3 win over UW-Eau Claire and it also notched an 8-1 win over St. Scholastica. In action against UWEC, the Huskies were led at #1 singles by Wojciech Batorski (Michalowice, Poland), who gained a 3-6, 7-6 (3), 10-4 win over Tim Eisele. At #2 singles, SCSU's Mike Master (Zimmerman) beat UWEC's Steve Lantz by a 6-1, 6-0 total. At #4 singles, SCSU's Tom Ronning (Alexandria) charted a 6-3, 6-3 win over UWEC's Emto Brudner and at #5 singles Kris Johnson (St. Cloud) of SCSU won 6-4, 7-6 (6) over UWEC's Phil Loprinzi. In doubles action, Batorski and Master won 8-5 over Eisele and Loprinzi at #1 doubles. Kevin Lukens (Wahpeton, N.D.) and Kris Johnson also carded an 8-5 win at #2 doubles over Lantz and Aaron Nordenskord of UWEC. To complete the day against St. Scholastica, Batorski (#1), Master (#2), Lukens (#3), Johnson (#5) and Ryan Schoenefeld (Watertown, S.D.) (#6) all won singles matches for the Huskies. In doubles play, Batorski and Master won at #1 doubles, while Lukens and Johnson improved to 2-0 on the season with a win at #2 doubles. Ronning and Schoenefeld ended the day with an 8-4 win at #3 doubles.

CONCORDIA FALLS: The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (3-0) tallied a 5-4 win over Concordia College on Saturday, Feb. 3, at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in nearby Sartell. Sophomore Kris Johnson, a resident of St. Cloud, brought home the victory with a big win at fifth singles with a 6-1, 7-5 tiebreak win over Kirby Johnson of CC. Mike Master (Zimmerman/Elk River H.S.) added a 6-2, 6-3 win at #2 singles over Wills Wischer of CC, while freshman Tom Ronning (Alexandria) gained a 6-2, 6-4 win at fourth singles. Sophomore Ryan Schoenefeld (Watertown, S.D.) also gained a 6-1, 6-4 win over David Nygaard of CC at sixth singles. In doubles play, the tandem of Schoenefeld and Ronning brought home an 8-3 win at #3 doubles for the Huskies. Of note, Master finished a strong weekend in his first matches as a Husky by winning 36 games and losing only six in singles play.

TEAM NOTES: SCSU's 13 NCC titles is best among league teams, and breaks the old tie of 10 along with Augie, UNC and UND...SCSU has won five consecutive NCC championships under the leadership of Jerry Anderson, and they have also advanced to the NCAA Regional tournament in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006...the Huskies return NCC champions Kevin Lukens (6th singles and third doubles), Kris Johnson (third doubles) and Joey Jachymowski (1st doubles and 4th singles)...the Huskies have won 18-or-more matches for the past six consecutive seasons - including 20 win seasons in 2006, 2005, 2002 and 2001...Wojciech Batorski was an Alabama state junior college champion at singles and doubles in 2006, while playing for Central Alabama Community College.



COACHING STAFF: Coach Jerry Anderson begins his 10th season with the Huskies in 2007. Anderson owns a 166-66 record at SCSU. His squads have won NCC titles in 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006. SCSU has also gained NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005 & 2006. A member of the SCSU tennis team from 1982-84, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior season. At Willmar C.C., Anderson earned All-Region 13 honors and earned a trip to the NJCAA nationals in 1981. Anderson graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in P.E., a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.
