## 2005 SCSU MEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: FINAL RELEASE



**UPCOMING MATCHES:** The St. Cloud State men's tennis team (22-3) completed its 2005 season with their fifth consecutive trip to the NCAA Division II tournament. In first round play, the Huskies posted a 5-2 win over CU-Colorado Springs, and then lost in second round play by a 5-2 margin to UN-Kearney. The season marked two firsts as the Huskies won their first NCAA tournament match and also hosted the NCAA regional for the first time in team history. Along the way, SCSU won its fourth consecutive NCC title in 2005.

**TOURNEY TIME:** SCSU collected its first NCAA Division II postseason victory with a 5-2 win over Colorado University-Colorado Springs in the opening round of the regional on May 6, in St. Cloud. The Huskies grabbed an early lead in the match with wins at second and first doubles. At second doubles, Jeff Horner and Titus Christianson posted a 9-7 win over CU-CS's Travis Sellentin and Jason Schultz. At first doubles, SCSU's duo of Tony Larson and Joey Jachymowski rolled to an 8-3 win over Sean Voorhies and Josh Johnson of CU-CS. The Mountain Lions gained their lone win in doubles play at third doubles as Eric Rivera and Jason Bisanti posted an 8-3 win over Dan Boulay and Michael Engdahl of SCSU. In singles play, the Huskies gained a 3-1 edge in the match as Christianson gained a 6-2, 6-3 decision at second singles over CU-CS's Rivera. Schultz added a 6-4, 6-4 win over SCSU's Travis Marohl at fourth singles to make the match score 3-2. At third singles, Engdahl posted a 6-2, 7-5 win over CU-CS's Sellentin. The match was iced when Boulay charted a 6-3, 7-5 win over CU-CS's Mark Kautilla...in the second round on May 7 in St. Cloud, the Huskies lost a 5-2 decision to UN-Kearney. UNK gained an early 2-1 lead after doubles play in the match. At number one doubles William Jacombe and Jorge Ramos posted an 8-2 win over SCSU's Larson and Jachymowski. At number two doubles, Christianson and Horner of SCSU charged back with an 8-6 win over Andres Espinosa and Tyson Thomas of UNK. At third doubles, UNK gained an early edge with an 8-4 win by Cory Ciccone and Nate Weigand over SCSU's Boulay and Engdahl. In singles play, Jacombe charted a 6-2, 6-0 win over SCSU's Larson at number one singles. At number two singles, Christianson responded with a 6-3, 6-1 win for the Huskies over UNK's Espinosa. At fourth singles, Ramos chalked up a 6-3, 6-2 win over SCSU's Travis Marohl. The match was ended when Weigand posted a 6-3, 6-1 win over SCSU's Engdahl at number three singles.

**ANOTHER YEAR, ANOTHER TITLE:** SCSU gained its fourth consecutive NCC team title and 12th overall conference crown at the 2005 North Central Conference championships on April 21-22 at the Gold's Gym Tennis Complex in Sartell. SCSU posted 35 points to claim top honors, while Winona State was second at 25, Augustana was third at 16 and Minnesota State, Mankato was fourth at 14. At first singles, Larson posted a 2-0 record and beat Winona's Gage Davidson 6-1, 6-2 in the title match. At second singles, Christianson gained a 6-0, 6-2 win in his title match over Andrew Krueger of Augustana. At third singles, SCSU's Engdahl chalked up a 6-3, 6-2 win over Augustana's Eric Olson. In play at fourth singles, Marohl rolled to a 6-3, 6-3 win over Will Nagel of Winona. SCSU's Jachymowski completed the title run with a 1-6, 6-2, 10-6 win over Kyle Savekoul of Winona in the fifth place bout. At sixth singles, Boulay placed second for SCSU with a 1-1 record. At first doubles, Larson and Jachymowski won top honors with an 8-4 win over Davidson and Josh Malwitz of Winona. Christianson and Horner marked a conference crown at second doubles with an 8-5 win, and Boulay and Engdahl won their title match at third doubles by an 8-4 tally.

**COACHING STAFF:** St. Cloud State men's tennis coach Jerry Anderson begins his 8th season with the Huskies in 2005. Anderson's teams have won NCC titles in 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005. Anderson owns a career record at SCSU of 141-61. In 2005, Anderson was named the ITA Region Coach of the Year and the NCC Coach of the Year. Of note, the Huskies have gained five consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bids under the leadership of Coach Anderson (2005, 2004, 2003, 2002 and 2001). A member of the St. Cloud State University tennis team from 1982-1984, Anderson served as a team captain during his senior campaign in 1984. He graduated from SCSU in 1984, with a degree in physical education, a minor in athletic coaching and driver education certification. He has been an assistant professor at SCSU since 1985. He also serves as the junior varsity girls' tennis coach at Monticello High School and served as the boys' and girls' junior varsity tennis coach at Anoka Senior High School from 1993 to 1995. Anderson is a resident of Big Lake.

**MORE TEAM NOTES:** SCSU was ranked #2 in the latest NCAA Division II North Central Region poll...SCSU has gained five consecutive NCAA tournament bids in 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 & 2005 ...SCSU's 12 NCC titles represent the most NCC crowns won by any team in any sport at SCSU...Titus Christianson has won three consecutive NCC titles at #2 singles for the Huskies, and two consecutive NCC titles at #2 double...SCSU has more NCC titles than any other conference school (past or present NCC member). Northern Colorado, Augustana and North Dakota have all won 10 NCC titles, while SCSU has won 12 since 1986 - including six crowns since 1997...Tony Larson was named the ITA's Player to Watch in the Region for 2005...Titus Christianson was named the ITA's Arthur Ashe Scholarship and Citizenship award winner for the Region in 2005...this marked the first time SCSU has hosted a regional tournament, and the first time SCSU has won a match in NCAA tournament play...the 22 wins by SCSU this spring is the second most in team history. In 2002, SCSU was 24-7...Titus Christianson was 25-1 in singles play this spring.
