2005 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: March 16, 2005



UPCOMING MATCHES: The St. Cloud State women's tennis team (11-5) will return to Gold's Gym in Sartell on March 19-21, for a series of home matches. On Saturday, March 19, SCSU will host Winona State at 9 a.m. On Sunday, March 20, the Huskies will play NCC rival Augustana College at 2 p.m. and on Monday, March 21, SCSU will play Metro State (Colo.) at 10:30 a.m.

HUSKIES UNDER THE SUN: Last week the Huskies travelled to the Orlando, Fla. area for a series of matches from March 6-11. SCSU posted a 2-3 record down south, which included matches against some very solid programs including Great Lakes region power Grand Valley State. On March 6, SCSU opened the trip with a 5-3 loss to Wittenberg. Nicole Lechner gained a 6-4, 6-4 win at #1 singles, while Lechner and Kelley Severson also won 8-5 at #1 doubles. On March 7, SCSU charted a 5-4 win over St. Mary's (Ind.). Lechner (#1) and Alyssa Achman (#5) both gained singles wins, while the match was iced by a Huskies' sweep in doubles play...on March 8, SCSU lost a tough 7-2 match to Grand Valley State. Kelley Severson (#3) and Kim Lindblom (#5) were winners in singles play for the Huskies...at St. Leo's, the Huskies lost a 5-4 match on March 10. Severson (#2), Lindblom (#4) and Jenna Vogel (#5) all won singles matches, while Lechner and Severson rolled to a win at #1 doubles...to end the trip, the Huskies notched a 5-4 win over Sacred Heart (a Division I opponent) on March 11. Sara Eull (#3), Vogel (#4), Lindblom (#5) and Achman (#6) all won singles matches, while Casie Siekman and Katie Harrison brought home the win with an 8-6 decision at #3 doubles.

TEAM NOTES: Kim Lindblom is still undefeated this season with a perfect 12-0 singles record...sophomore Jenna Vogel ranks second on the team this season with 10 singles wins (10-5)...in doubles play, Nicole Lechner and Kelley Severson lead the team with an 11-4 record...SCSU has added a home match against Winona State on March 19... Lechner and Sara Eull have been designated as team captains in 2005...SCSU gained its second consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bid in 2004. Overall, SCSU has been invited to the NCAA tournament three times. The other trip to the NCAAs was in 1995...both Lechner and Eull have notched over 100 career wins at SCSU...SCSU posted its 17th consecutive winning season in 2004, which featured an 18-7 record. At the NCC championships, the Huskies placed third behind first place UND and runner-up Nebraska-Omaha...fans, mark April 22-23 on your calendars since that is when the Huskies will host the 2005 North Central Conference championships at Gold's Gym. The tournament will be making a return to St. Cloud for the first time in over two seasons.

COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State women's tennis coach Larry Sundby begins his 18th season with the Huskies in 2005. In 18 seasons at SCSU, Sundby has compiled a 304-125 record and led the Huskies to three North Central Conference titles in 1988, 1990 and 1991. He was voted the North Central Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991. Sundby has also led SCSU to NCAA Division II tournament bids in 1995, 2003 and 2004. Sundby is in his 27th season overall as a high school and collegiate tennis coach. As a tennis coach, his teams have compiled a 432-168 overall record. He was recognized as the Minnesota High School Girl's Class AA Tennis Coach of the Year in 1992. Sundby is a professor emeritus of accounting at St. Cloud State University. He is assisted this year by Scott Johnson and Mark Muntiferung.
