2005 SCSU WOMEN'S TENNIS TEAM NEWS

Release Date: April 25, 2005



UPCOMING MATCHES: The St. Cloud State women's tennis team (18-8) will be awaiting word on a potential bid to the NCAA Division II North Central Regional Tournament on May 6-7. SCSU has gained two consecutive bids to the NCAA tournament in 2003 and 2004. SCSU also gained a bid to the NCAA tournament in 1995 - all under the leadership of current coach Larry Sundby. At present, SCSU is ranked #5 in the latest NCAA regional poll - with the top eight teams typically receiving an NCAA bid.

SCSU FINISHES THIRD AT NCC MEET: The St. Cloud State women's tennis team finished third at the 2005 North Central Conference championships. Nebraska-Omaha was the team champs with 58 points, while UND was second at 54. SCSU had 40 points, and Augustana had 37. Minnesota State (26), South Dakota (19) and Minnesota Duluth (18) completed the field. Jenna Vogel led SCSU with a first place finish at fifth singles, which included a 6-4, 3-6 (10-5) win over Sarah Huls of UND in the title match...Third place finishes for the Huskies were notched by Kelley Severson at #3 singles and Kim Lindblom at #4 singles. At first singles, Nicole Lechner placed fourth and Sara Eull was fifth at #2 singles. Alyssa Achman was also fifth at #6 singles. In doubles play, Lechner and Severson were third at #1 doubles and Eull and Klein were third at #2 doubles. At #3 doubles, Lindblom and Vogel placed fifth.

TEAM NOTES: The Huskies are ranked #5 in the latest NCAA DII North Central Regional poll...Jenna Vogel won SCSU's first singles title in over 10 seasons at the NCC championships. The last time SCSU won an NCC title, the doubles team of Sara Eull and Courtney Hover won the title at #2 doubles in 2003...Lechner and Sara Eull have been designated as team captains in 2005...SCSU gained its second consecutive NCAA Division II tournament bid in 2004. Overall, SCSU has been invited to the NCAA tournament three times. The other trip to the NAAs was in 1995...both Lechner and Eull have notched over 100 career wins at SCSU...SCSU posted its 17th consecutive winning season in 2004, which featured an 18-7 record. At the NCC championships, the Huskies placed third behind first place UND and runner-up Nebraska-Omaha...SCSU has placed no lower than fourth place in the NCC championships. Since 1980, the Huskies have finished lower than third place only three times at their conference championships.

COACHING STAFF: St. Cloud State women's tennis coach Larry Sundby begins his 18th season with the Huskies in 2005. In 18 seasons at SCSU, Sundby has compiled a 311-128 record and led the Huskies to three North Central Conference titles in 1988, 1990 and 1991. He was voted the North Central Conference Coach of the Year in 1988 and 1991. Sundby has also led SCSU to NCAA Division II tournament bids in 1995, 2003 and 2004. Sundby is in his 27th season overall as a high school and collegiate tennis coach. As a tennis coach, his teams have compiled a 439-171 overall record. He was recognized as the Minnesota High School Girl's Class AA Tennis Coach of the Year in 1992. Sundby is a professor emeritus of accounting at St. Cloud State University. He is assisted this year by Scott Johnson and Mark Muntifering.
