TRACK TEAMS TRAVEL TO THE UNIVERSITY OF MINNESOTA: The St. Cloud State University men's and women's track teams will travel to the U of M Friday and Saturday, February 17-18. The men will compete in the Snowshoe Open on Friday and the women will compete in the Parents Day Open on Saturday. The events will be held in the U of M Fieldhouse, time TBA.

HUSKY RESULTS FROM SCSU OPEN (St. Cloud, Minn.): The St. Cloud State women's track and field team posted four first place finishes and the men's squad had three top spots at the SCSU Open held Friday afternoon at Halenbeck South Fieldhouse.

Junior Kayla Todnem (St. James) paced the Huskies with a first place finish in the long jump with a mark of 16' 8" and placed second in the 55 meter hurdles with a time of 8.83. Senior Jodi Rosborough (Bismarck, ND) won the pole vault to capture her third first place marker this season in the event, with a height of 11'1/4". Junior Lindsey Krueger (Rochester) posted a height of 5'2 3/4" to win the high jump and took third behind Todnem in the 55 meter hurdles with a time of 9.07. First year runner Emily Winans (Fergus Falls) won the mile run in a time of 5:33.56. Sophomore Amanda Kunkel (Eden Prairie) placed second in both the weight throw and shot put. Senior Sarah Getty (Remer) slid into the second place position in the 5000 meter run with a time of 18:09.21. Sophomore Mikha Tan (Sioux City, Iowa) sprinted her way to a third place finish in the 55 meter dash with a time of 7.55 and took fourth behind fellow sophomore Amber Shueler (Glencoe) in the 200 meter dash with times of 27.84 and 27.6 respectively. Rounding out the top five finishes for the Husky women was sophomore Bobbi Krippner (Mankato) placing fourth in the 800 meter run with 2:26.24.

On the men's side, senior Steve Bader (Fargo, ND) won the 200 meter dash in 22.63. Sophomore Michael Graham (Oakdale) won the 55 meter dash in :06.44 and teammate Kyle Ewing (Richland Center, WI) was second in :06.50. Junior Bryan Pearson (Anoka) was the winner in the high jump with a height of 6'6 1/4". Junior Aaron Wolfram (Maplewood) placed second in the weight throw and fifth in the shot put. Sophomore David Manly (Minneapolis) took second place in the 800 meter run with 1:59.25. Four of the Husky men placed third in their events, that includes: senior Ryan Koch (Madison, Wisc.) in the pole vault with 4.11m, sophomore Kyle Ewing (Richland Center, Wisc.) in the long jump with 6.72m, junior Jared Lazer (Sauk Rapids) in the 55 meter hurdles with 8.07 and first year Ted Johnson (Neenah, Wisc.) in the 3000 meter run with 9:27.23.

PLAYER PROFILE OF THE WEEK: Junior Aaron Wolfram continues to take the top seat in division II weight throw at indoor track and field meets thus far this season. Hailing from Maplewood, Minn., he attended high school at St. Croix Lutheran where he competed in various track and field events. At SCSU he has dominated the field throwing events, taking first or second in the weight throw at all-DII and DIII track meets that the Huskies have competed in. At the Husky Open he took first in the weight throw, just missing an NCAA provisional qualifying mark with a throw of 16.57m but was able to hit that mark two weeks ago in Mankato, Minn. (his favorite place to compete), at the MSU Open with a toss of 17.2m. At the multi-division meet, the ISU Open, in Ames, Iowa, he threw 15.88m to pull in the ten spot. This past weekend he took second in the weight throw with a toss of 16.99m. He has also made his mark in the shot put where he has placed second, fifth, ninth and 13th this season. At the 2005 outdoor NCC championships, Wolfram took fourth in the hammer throw and fifth in the shot put.

Wolfram hopes to be the NCC weight throw champion this season, to make the NCAA DII Individual Track and Field Championships in which he has set a goal to be a participant. His most memorable moment as a Husky has been the 2005 Indoor Conference meet at USD. Some of his favorites are Fox' The Family Guy, The DaVinci Code, AnchorMan, and listening to Ludacris. In the future Wolfram hopes to achieve the status of a chief of a department in the police force, as he is majoring in criminal justice at SCSU.
