TRACK TEAMS MAKE BIG LEAPS AT THE NCC CHAMPIONSHIPS: The St. Cloud State University men's track team took home fourth place at the NCC Indoor Track and Field Championships, while the women took seventh after competing at Mankato, Minn. at the Myers Fieldhouse on Feb. 24-25. The Huskies were led by one first place finish and their four provisional qualifiers of the day, who earned a slot on the list for a chance to compete at the NCAA Championships held in Boston, Mass., on March 10-11.

Jared Lazer led the men's squad with his first place finish in the 400 meter dash with a time of 50.20 seconds. Sophomore Kyle Ewing broke the school record in the long jump with his second place finish with a jump of 7.21 meters. He also reached a provisional qualifying mark with his second place finish in the 60 meter dash with a time of 7.04 seconds. Junior Aaron Wolfram took home a third place finish along with his second time this season reaching the NCAA provisional mark in the weight throw with a hurl of 17.10 meters. Wolfram also placed fourth in the shot put with 14.54 meters. Senior Ryan Koch came in second to Josh Rasmussen of Minnesota State Mankato in the pentathlon, breaking his school record set earlier this year in the pentathlon with 3672 points. He also had a fifth place finish in the 60 meter hurdles with 8.72 seconds. Michael Graham placed fourth in the finals of the 60 meter dash with a time of 6.94, he had already qualified for the NCAA championships earlier this season. Steve Bader also took a fourth slot in the 200 meter dash with 22.59 seconds. Bryan Pearson took a fifth place finish in the high jump with a leap of 1.94 meters. As a team, the men's squad ended with 82.33 points under ten points away from third which was their goal.

The women's squad was led by Amanda Kunkel who had two-second place finishes in the shot put and the weight throw with a provisional qualifying mark in the shot put with 13.35 meters and 14.32 meters in the weight throw. Jodi Rosborough took third in the Pole Vault with a lift of 3.71 meters, she met a provisional mark for the third time this season and will be the only Husky traveling to Boston to compete in the NCAA DII Indoor Championships on March 10-11. Sarah Getty took fourth in the 5000 meter run with a time of 18:00.97, just .17 of a second over the provisional qualifying mark. Two other leaders for SCSU were Lindsey Krueger and Kayla Todnem in the pentathlon with a third (3242 points) and a fourth place (3174 points) finish respectively. The women's team missed their goal of 50 points by one point, scoring 49 in their NCC competition which was more than double of the teams total indoor score last year.



COACH MISCHKE'S CORNER: SCSU's Head Coach Seth Mischke is in his sixth year as the head coach of the SCSU men's and women's track and cross country programs. Last season, Mischke was named the 2005 NCC Men's Indoor Track and Field Coach of the Year as he led the Huskies to a third place finish. He felt that the Husky tracksters had made major improvements this year and says, "Our athletes were very happy with the competition at the NCC Championships, a lot of good things happened."

ROSBOROUGH PREPARES FOR NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS: Despite six Husky tracksters making it on the NCAA Indoor Track and Field provisional qualifying lists this season, only one will travel to the NCAA Championships. Jodi Rosborough (Bismark, ND) will be traveling to Boston, Mass., to compete in the NCAA Championships on March 10-11, at the Reggie Lewis Track and Athletic Center.

Rosborough's marks in the pole vault competition at the SCSU Open on January 21, earned her a slot on the provisional qualifying list with a vault of 3.55 meters. She met the provisional mark for the third time this season at the NCC Championships with a lift of 3.71 meters (12' 2"). Coach Mischke and Rosborough will leave for the NCAA Championships on Wednesday, March 8th, and will compete in the Pole Vault on Saturday, March 11. Rosborough was listed at ninth on the provisional lists behind conference rival Katelin Rains from MSUM and tied with Katie Cerling of South Dakota. They all trail leader Jennifer Hensel of UM-Moorhead who had a qualifying vault of 13' 1.5".

SCSU's Kyle Ewing missed the cut-off for the NCAA Championships by .75 inches in the long jump after breaking the school's record in the long jump at the NCC's last week. The final list for the long jump in the NCAA Championships took the top 16 jumpers and Ewing was listed at number 19. Micheal Graham missed the cut-off by six competitors and three-hundredths of a second for his time in the 60 meter dash. Aaron Wolfram also missed the cut-off mark set in the weight throw, he was nearly one foot behind Robert Klenk from Ashland College. Lindsey Krueger was listed in the number 20 slot for the provisional qualifying list, just 2.75 inches behind the leader. Amanda Kunkel was the final Husky to qualify for the lists but ranked 29th did not qualify her to travel.

The NCAA Division II Indoor Track and Field Championships will begin at 10 a.m. on Friday the 10th of March and at 9 a.m. on Saturday, March 11th.
