**ROSBOROUGH VIES FOR THE NCAA POLE VAULT TITLE:** Running with a pole and vaulting yourself twelve feet and twelve inches in the air lasts only a few seconds and may earn you the thrill of a lifetime but it earned one St. Cloud State University Track and Field member a trip to the NCAA DII Indoor Track and Field Championships and a memory that will last a lifetime.

Jodi Rosborough (Bismarck, N.D.) is the only Husky trackster headed to the NCAA Championships on March 10-11, in Boston, Mass., at the Reggie Lewis Track and Athletic Center. She proved to her teammates that she earned her trip but she wasn't looking to prove it to them, she was proving it to herself.

After taking a year off of the SCSU track and field team for the 2004-05 season, Rosborough felt lost. Being an active twenty-something year old she kept up her regiment of working out and attending classes but felt as if she was missing that goal that she was working towards while she was on the team.

"Soon after I began to sit the season out I knew I had to come back, I am a competitor and I wanted to finish my eligibility," Rosborough stated, "I want to be retired not known as a quitter."

Retired is something she wants after her trip to Boston. "At the championships I want to remain consistent, I've only made it over 12'2" once and I want to make it there again." Rosborough's pole vault of 12'2" at the NCC Championships on Feb. 24-25 gave her a bid into the NCAA Championships. She had hit the provisional mark at the SCSU Open on Jan. 21, with a vault of 3.55 meters, but knew that if she wanted a guaranteed trip she knew she had to get over that mark.

"I really wanted to be over 12 feet this season, and to be close to the school record," Rosborough said about her goals, "After looking at the records I feel that if I get that extra something at Boston I might give it a good run."

Rosborough will not only give it a good run for the school record but plans on sticking it to her main competitors. The Bismarck native took third at the NCC's to Katelin Rains from Mankato who had a vault of 12'6" and South Dakota's Katie Cerling (who had the same finals jump height as Rosborough but different provisional lifts). Rosborough was seeded ninth on the provisional ranking list tied with Cerling, but behind Rains who was listed as fourth.

"I expect nothing than the best from both of them," Rosborough said, "I just want to be able to keep my streak going against Jessica Fleck from North Dakota."

Fleck, a native of Wahpeton, N.D., has competed against Rosborough every year since their sophomore years in high school and went into the state championships their senior seasons as the No.1 and No.2 seeds. "I just want to keep my reign over her, I've seen her forever and since the NCAA took fifteen instead of twelve, she will get her chance to prove her worth also."

Hailing from Bismarck, N.D., Rosborough was a three-sport athlete in high school competing in gymnastics, diving and the pole vault. A lifelong gymnast, she heard that pole vaulting would come easy to her and the first time she saw the event she knew it was love at first sight. "You get a rush participating and watching the event that you can't get from anything else."

A community psychology major at SCSU feels that she will start working in group homes and hopes that someday it will lead her to working in schools where she can pursue coaching. "I want others to feel as good as I did after my big vault, it (the NCC's vault) was the best moment of my pole vaulting career thus far, making it over that bar on the first attempt, landing on the mat and seeing the bar still there was a surreal moment."

Surreal as it seemed, it earned her a way to the NCAA Championships. Rosborough and Coach Mischke will leave for Boston on March 8 to attend the Track and Field Banquet and to mentally prepare in the unfamiliar place. Rosborough will compete in the pole vault on March 11. No matter the outcome of the event, Rosborough concluded her interview with saying she feels happy, and is back to the level before she took time off.

"I have one more attempt to get things done, this is for me, to prove to myself that I am a winner."
