JODI ROSBOROUGH COMPETES AT NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS: Just making the trip was enough to prove to herself that she could really compete with the best in her division for Jodi Rosborough after competing at the NCAA DII Track and Field Championships Saturday, March 11, at the Reggie Lewis Track and Athletics Center in Boston, Mass.

Despite battling the flu, Rosborough took to the field but was unable to provide any competition as she faulted on her three attempts at 3.50 meters. The willingness to attempt the vaults showed the determination that has been with her all season.

Rosborough qualified for the NCAA's hitting the provisional mark at the second meet of the indoor season, hosted by the Huskies and continued her leadership position throughout the winter months. She hit her top mark of 12'2" at the NCC Indoor Championships on Feb. 25, and jumped up to the No. 9 spot in the nation. Conference rival, Katelin Rains of Minnesota State, took fourth overall in the NCAA Division II Championships.

Rosborough was the only Husky to travel to Boston despite five provisional qualifiers on the team. Kyle Ewing missed the cut-off for the NCAA Championships by .75 inches in the long jump after breaking the school's record in the long jump at the NCC Tournament and also missed the trip to Boston in the 60 meter dash. Even more devastating was the cut-off in the 60 meter-dash where Michael Graham missed the time by three-hundredths of a second. Aaron Wolfram also missed the trip to Boston being nearly one foot behind the leader. Lindsey Krueger was listed at the number 20 slot for the women's high jump where the cut-off was at 12 competitors. The final Husky was Amanda Kunkel who took second in the shot put at the NCC's.

Other highlights from the season was the men's team's fourth place finish at the NCC championships where they were just under ten points away from their goal of third place. The women missed their goal at the NCC Tournament by one point, aiming for 50. Ewing broke the record in the men's long jump, while Ryan Koch broke the school record in the men's pentathlon record twice this season. The first new record was set at the Minnesota State Mankato Open where he took first in the event, and broke again at the NCC Championships taking second overall. The new record now sits at 3672 points.

OUTDOOR SEASON OUTLOOK: The outdoor track season for the St. Cloud State tracksters begins March 26-27 at the Northwest Missouri Multi held in Maryville, Missouri, events held all day long.

Be on the lookout for the SCSU men's team to step up their fight for the top of the NCC, as the indoor season showed the depth from veterans to rookies on the team along with the top provisional qualifiers during the winter season. Ryan Koch will make an attempt at his fourth consecutive trip to the NCAA Championships in the decathlon after taking sixth in 2005, fourth in 2004, and eleventh in 2003. The All-American made waves in the pentathlon during the indoor season that better prepared him for doubling the events in the outdoor season.

The women's team should continue to improve as the distance runners will pick up the tail end of the team and show their determination on the tar. Be on the look-out for Rosborough to pick up the pace in the pole vault after her finish at the NCAA Indoor Championships.
