**THREE DAYS OF EVENTS BRING SCSU TO KANSAS:** The St. Cloud State University Husky outdoor track and field team will travel to Emporia, Kansas on Thursday, April 13, to face three days of competition at Emporia State University, events held at the Zola Witten Track in the Fran Welch Stadium.

Thursday, April 13, and Friday, April 14, will hold events for the women's heptathlon and the men's decathlon. Events for the heptathlon will begin at 3:30 p.m. on Thursday and at 11:30 a.m. on Friday. The decathlon will begin on the 13th at 3:00 p.m. and at 10:30 a.m. on the 14th.

The Division II Challenge will be held on Saturday, April 15, with field events beginning at 9:00 a.m., the men's hammer throw and running events starting at 10:45 a.m., and the women's 100 meter hurdles preliminaries starting at 10:45 a.m. The only exception in the DII challenge is that the 10,000 meter run will be held on Friday at 6:45 p.m. Results for the DII challenge and the multi-event meet can be viewed on Emporia State's web page: <http://www.emporia.edu/athletics/track/index.html>

**HUSKIES OPEN OUTDOOR SEASON IN TOP SPEED:** Senior Katie Wilson (Grand Forks, N.D.) led the SCSU track and field teams with a first place in the javelin throw, breaking her own school record set in 2004 and moved into the top slot on the NCAA DII javelin throw list with a throw of 148 feet and 6 inches at the Falcon Invitational on April 8th, in River Falls, Wisc.

Also leading the Husky women was senior Sarah Getty (Remer), who took first in the 5000 meter run with a time of 18:07.13. Amanda Kunkel tallied the women's third first place finish with a 44 foot 3.75 inch toss of the shot put, she also tallied a second place finish with a hammer throw of 139 feet and 1 inch. Other top five finishers in the running events were sophomore Holly Dombrowski took fourth place in the 400 meter dash with 61.79, and Emily Winans with a time of 5:07.32 in the 1500 meter run. Two-sport athlete, Heather Miller led the Husky pack in the long jump with a third place finish, leaping 16 feet 7.25 inches and was followed by Mikha Tan in fifth and Angela Knobloch in seventh. Cassandra Moe was able to claim a third place finish in the triple jump with 33 feet 3 inches. Kristin Otterson tossed the hammer just under six feet shorter than Kunkel to earn the fourth spot in the hammer throw. Lindsey Krueger grabbed herself two top-five finishes taking third in the high jump with 5 feet 1 inch and trailed Wilson in the javelin taking fourth. Danielle Larson wrapped up the top-five women finishes with a fifth place finish in the pole vault, clearing the bar at 9 feet 9.25 inches. The 4x100 meter relay team took second place just over two-tenths of a second behind Wisconsin-Stout, and the 4x400 relay team took third.

The Husky men made leaps and bounds taking twelve top-five places, led by Steve Bader who took one of the men's three individual first place finishes in the 200 meter dash with a time of 22.19. Kyle Ewing continued his top jumping style in the long jump taking first with a jump of 21 feet and 8 inches, nearly two feet above teammate Bryan Pearson who took fourth in the event. Junior Jarred Lazer took the final first place mark in the 400 meter hurdles with a time of 55.05, and was followed by freshmen Bob Cowell and Ben Held who took fourth and fifth in the event respectively. Pearson was able to claim another top-three finish, placing second in the high jump clearing the bar at 6 feet 2.75 inches. Sophomore Kyle Ewing took fifth in the 100 meter dash with a time of 11.33. Also claiming a top-five spot was Sam Johnson in fifth in the 400 meter dash with 51.39 and Isaiah Fuller with fourth in the pole vault clearing the bar at 12 feet 11.5 inches. The Husky men 4x100 relay team took first, topping Wisconsin-Eau Claire by .23 seconds.

**SCSU HEAD COACH SETH MISCHKE:** Seth Mischke (University of Minnesota, 1997) is in his sixth year as head coach of the SCSU men's and women's track and cross country programs. Prior to becoming the SCSU head coach, Mischke was a Husky assistant for a year. Mischke is a 1997 graduate of the University of Minnesota where he was a member of the Golden Gophers men's track and field team and was a consistent top eight finisher in the Big Ten Championships. He is a native of Worland, Wyoming and was a standout athlete at Worland High School - located in scenic north central Wyoming. Mischke and his wife Colleen Mischke reside in St. Cloud, with their two children Brooklyn and Tanner.
