**SPEEDY LEGS TRAVEL TO DRAKE RELAYS:** The St. Cloud State University Husky track and field team will compete in the annual Drake Relays in Des Moines, Iowa, on April 26-29. The Huskies will be competing against athletes from 78 different countries, including, as Drake University Athletics reported, three athletes with world's best marks.

The Huskies that will be competing in the Drake Relays will be Katie Wilson, who individually qualified in the javelin, and Sarah Getty who also qualified in the 10K. SCSU will also send both men and women's relay teams in the 4x100, 4x200 and in the sprint medley. Getty's event will be held on Thursday at 4:25 p.m., Wilson will compete at 2:00 p.m. on Friday and the relay teams will compete on Saturday.

**KOCH AIMS FOR FIRST TOP FINISH IN THE DECATHLON AT NCC MULTI'S:** Senior Ryan Koch hopes to sweep the competition in the decathlon at the North Central Conference Multi Championships next Monday and Tuesday the 1-2 of May. It will be Koch's fourth attempt at the title, taking second in 2005, third in 2004 and placing fifth in 2003. He is currently ranked second on the provisional qualifying list for the NCAA DII Multi Championships and leads the NCC.

The NCC Multi Championships will begin at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, and will be hosted by the University of South Dakota in Yankton, S.D.

**STRONG FINISH FOR WOMEN AT BISON OPEN, LED BY WILSON AND SCHUELER:** Sophomore Amber Schueler claimed her first-first place finish this season at the Bison Open on Saturday, April 22, in the 400 meter hurdles and senior Katie Wilson kept her streak of top finishes alive in the javelin throw.

Wilson extends her streak to three consecutive first place finishes in the javelin throw. Schueler clocked in at 1:10.99 just three and a half seconds in front of teammate Cassandra Moe, who took third in the event. Emily Winans also received two top three finishes, taking second in the 1500 meter run with 4:55.02 and third in the 3000 meter run with 11:01.10. Jodi Rosborough earned a second place finish in the pole vault, clearing the bar at 11 feet 6 inches, and just a foot below that was Danielle Larson, who took fourth in the event. Lindsey Krueger took the top finish for DII athletes in the 100 meter hurdles with a third place finish behind an unattached runner, McKenzie Mehlisch, of NDSU. Throwing herself into second and third place finishes was Amanda Kunkel in the hammer throw and the shot put with lengths of 44.11m and 46'6" respectively. The women's 4x100 relay team took second behind the host school (NDSU) with a time of 50.12 seconds.

Also making leaps and bounds for the women's team was Holly Dombrovski, who took fourth in the 400 meter dash and fifth in the 200 meter dash with times of 59.74 and 26.93. Mikha Tan was able to grab a top five spot, placing fifth in the 100 meter dash with a time of 13.18. Two-sport athlete, Heather Miller, led the field of DII athletes in the long jump with a leap of 5.42 meters, placing sixth behind four NDSU athletes and an unattached jumper. Kristin Otterson placed fourth behind Kunkel in the hammer throw with a toss of 43.25 meters and also grabbed a sixth place finish in the discus throw.

The Husky men were lead by Juniors Bryan Pearson and Kyle Ewing who both took second place finishes in the high jump and long jump respectively. Pearson cleared the high jump bar at 6'6" the same as the first place jumper but took one more attempt to earn the second place finish. He also claimed fourth place in the long jump behind Ewing, who leaped 6.83m to take second. Jared Lazer claimed third place in the 400 meter dash with a time of 49.27. Ryan Koch led the DII competitors in the 400 meter hurdles with a time of 58.46, sliding into third place and leading teammate Ben Held who took fourth in the event with a time of 1:00.73. Koch also led his division competitors in the javelin throw, placing sixth with a toss of 49.92 meters.

Steve Bader flew by all but one DII competitor in the 200 meter dash taking fifth with a time of 22.16. Bob Colwell tallied a fourth place finish in the 110 meter hurdles just three hundredths of a second in front of Held, who took fifth in the event. St. Cloud State's men's 4x100 relay team took second in the event with a time of 42.82.
