Huskies to Compete at UW-River Falls: The St. Cloud State Men's and Women's track and field teams will compete at the University of Wisconsin-River Falls on Saturday, April 9. The field events will get underway at 11:00 a.m. followed by the running events at 12 noon.

Last Week: The Huskies had many athletes compete at the Sixth Annual University of Missouri Relays last Friday and Saturday. On the men's side, four Madison, Wisconsin natives finished in the top 15 in the javelin led by senior Jason Koch who placed fourth with a mark of 175'6". Junior Ryan Koch placed sixth with a mark of 172'8", first year Adam Stueck was eighth with a throw of 164' and first year Andy Koch was 15th with a mark of 139'5". In other field events, sophomore Aaron Wolfram (Maplewood) placed 13th in the hammer throw with a toss of 152'7" and senior Kevin Holubar (Duluth) placed 15th with a mark of 148'3". Holubar placed 12th in the shot put (45' 11 3/4") and Wolfram 17th (43'8"). Ryan Koch placed 15th in the men's long jump with a mark of 19' 10 3/4" and Andy Koch was tenth in the triple jump with a mark of 38' 9/12". Sophomore Bryan Pearson (Anoka) placed seventh in the high jump with a leap of 6' 4 3/4". In the men's running events, sophomore Jared Lazer (Sauk Rapids) placed tenth in the 400 meter hurdles with a time of 56.04.

On the women's side senior Kari Turkowski (Cold Spring) placed 12th in the javelin with a throw of 93'8" and was 13th in the hammer throw with a mark of 127'. Junior Kayla Todnem (St. James) placed ninth in the long jump with a mark of 17'2". Todnem and first year Cassandra Moe (Dassel) placed sixth (33'2") and seventh (31' 10 1/4"), respectively in the triple jump. Sophomore Lindsey Krueger (Rochester) placed tenth in the high jump with a mark of 5'1" and sophomore Amanda Faulkner (Sandstone) placed 12th in with a height of 4'9". In the women's running events, sophomore Beth Sandoval (Rice) placed tenth in the 3000 meter run with a time of 10:44.23. She also placed 16th in the 800 meter run with a time of 2:20.43.

Head Coach: Seth Mischke (Minnesota, 1997) is in his sixth year as head coach of the St. Cloud State track and field program and fourth year as cross country coach. During Mischke's short head coaching career, he has already coached 11 NCAA Division II All-Americans and several North Central Conference champions. A native of Worland, Wyoming, Mischke is married to assistant coach Colleen McKinney Mischke; the couple reside in St. Cloud with daughter, Brooklyn. He is Level I and Level II USATF Jumps and Throws Certified.

Mischke Honored: St. Cloud State head coach Seth Mischke was named the 2005 North Central Conference Men's Indoor Coach of the Year. Mischke led the Huskies to a third place indoor finish, their best since a third place finish in 1999. It was also an improvement over the Huskies fifth place finish in 2004.

NCC Title for Wolfram: SCSU sophomore Aaron Wolfram (Maplewood) won the NCC title in the shot put with a throw of 50 feet and 3/4 inch. He also gave the Huskies points with his fifth place finish in the weight throw (53-7). He is the first NCC indoor champion for the Huskies since the 2002 season.
