## St. Cloud State Lands 21 on Fall NSIC All-Academic Squad

St. Paul, Minn. – The Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference has announced its All-Academic Teams for the 2008 fall athletics season. St. Cloud State totaled 21 student-athletes on the respective academic squads, including three from cross country, eight from football, seven from soccer and three from volleyball.

To be eligible for this honor, the student-athlete must be a member of the varsity traveling team and have a cumulative grade point average of 3.20 or better. Furthermore, the student-athlete must have reached sophomore academic and athletic standing at the institution represented with one full year completed at that particular institution.

Senior **Kelley Nelson** (Westbrook), junior **Ben Wagner** (Buffalo) and sophomore **Paula Marozas** (Andover) represented St. Cloud State from the men's and women's cross country teams on the NSIC All-Academic Team.

For football, the Huskies were represented by seniors **David Kamin** (Menomonee Falls, Wis.), **Ryan Kees** (Eagan) and **Tyler Krueger** (Milwaukee, Wis.). Also on the NSIC All-Academic squad for football from St. Cloud State was **Brian Kampa**, a junior from Sartell, and sophomores **Nick Angellotti** (Wauconda, Ill.), **Justin Delgado** (Burlington, Wis.), **Jake Machacek** (Eagan) and **Joe Winandy** (Mazomanie, Wis.).

St. Cloud State had seven soccer players earn NSIC All-Academic honors this fall. Those players include seniors **Jessica Cody** (Menomonie, Wis.), **Amy Lindstrom** (Fridley) and **Abigail Maruish** (Burnsville), junior **Chelsey Scheller** (Maple Grove), and sophomores **Teresa Gazich** (Arden Hills), **Jessica Pafko** (Blaine) and **Danielle Peterson** (Rochester).

The final three Huskies to gain NSIC All-Academic status were volleyball players **Alecia Lunde** (So., East Bethel), **Andreana Pieper** (Sr., Williams) and **Shanna Seidel** (Jr., Maple Grove).
