2008 SCSU VOLLEYBALL NEWS

THIS WEEK'S OPPONENT: The Huskies will conclude their eight-game road trip with Division I and former North Central Conference partner South Dakota. The Coyotes have started the season hot, streaking to eight straight victories to start the season, including four against Division I foes. Below is a brief glimpse at the Coyotes:

SCSU POSTS THIRD PLACE FINISH AT NANOOK CLASSIC:

St. Cloud State's season-opening trek took them on the longest road trip in the history of the program...to Fairbanks, Alaska. The Huskies were cooled by some tough competition, but still earned third place at the tournament with a 1-2 mark. Game one pitted SCSU versus the nation's 23rd ranked team in Ashland (Ohio). The Huskies came out strong, taking the first set, but Ashland responded to take the next three, taking a 3-1 victory from the Huskies. Game two matched SCSU up against host Alaska, Fairbanks, a team that had upset 13th ranked Central Missouri the previous week. The Nanooks, 8-2 on the season, proved it was no fluke as they handled the Huskies 3-0. The Huskies captured third, however, with a stellar all-around performance sweeping Catawba (N.C.) 3-0. Ashland would go on to win the tournament with a 3-2 victory over UAF in the final game.

2008 RECORD: The Huskies have yet to play their first home match, and are 2-5 overall on the season. The Huskies schedule has been tough, featuring two ranked teams, and a combined opponent record of 33-24 (.579).

WATERMAN KEEPS CLIMBING:

Jennifer Waterman (Anoka) moved up to eighth on the all-time Husky career assists list with another solid effort in the Huskies' three matches. Waterman is moving in on 1500 career assists, as she recorded 95 this past weekend, including a season-high 39 assists in the 3-0 sweep of Catawba. She is currently sitting at 1389 assists in her short career.

PIEPER NETS ALL-TOURNAMENT TEAM HONORS:

Husky senior Andreana Pieper (Williams) added another honor to her sparkling college resume, as she was named to the Nanook Classic All-Tournament Team this past weekend. Pieper, a vital part of the Husky defense for the last 3+ seasons, recorded 68 digs on the weekend. On top of the digs, she accumulated a .981

reception percentage and added four assists to the Husky attack.

SENIOR CAPTAIN TABS NSIC POW HONOR:

Andreana Pieper (Williams), St. Cloud State's all-time career digs leader, was named the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference Defensive Player of the Week after landing herself on the 2008 Nanook Classic All-Tournament Team. Pieper is the first Husky to gain an NSIC POW award this season.

FRESHMAN FIRSTS: Two Husky first years saw their first career action this past weekend. Red-shirt first year Amy Gatz (Winsted) played in the Ashland and Alaska matches, recording four kills and five blocks (0s/5a). Johanna Knutson (Watkins), a true first year, saw her first action against Ashland posting her first dig of her young Husky career.

EFFECTIVE "O": The Huskies had their most efficient offensive showing of the young season in the last game against Catawba. The Huskies recorded season-bests in kills, with 47 and attack percentage with a .246 mark.

Originally from Lino Lakes, Minn., Bostrom is a 2001 graduate from Centennial High School in Circle Pines, Minn. Bostrom went on to play collegiate volleyball at South Dakota State University from 2001-2004. The two-time team captain was fortunate enough to experience SDSU's move from Division II to Division I, and during her senior season in 2004, Bostrom was named to the Division I All-Independent Conference team. Bostrom currently resides in St. Cloud and is pursuing a master's degree in sport management at St. Cloud State University.

THE HUSKY-COYOTE SERIES

St. Cloud State has had quite the upper hand over their upcoming opponent South Dakota. The Huskies are an impressive 31-13 against the Coyotes in the two teams' history, but have dropped the last three matches. Below is a look at the two team's recent history:

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE NORTHERN SUN CONFERENCE

Since 1932, various institutions have competed in the NSIC. Bemidji State University, Minnesota State University Moorhead and Winona State University are charter members and have remained in the conference for the 76 years of its existence.

Minnesota State University, Mankato and St. Cloud State were also charter members, but left the league in 1981 (MSU left the league in 1969 and returned in 1977). The University of Minnesota Duluth, which departed the league in 2005-06 through 2007-08 seasons, was also an original member.

Other current members joined in later years: Southwest Minnesota State University in 1969, Northern State University in 1978, Wayne State College (Nebraska) in 1998, Concordia University, St. Paul and the University of Minnesota, Crookston in 1999, the University of Mary and Upper Iowa University in 2006 and Augustana College in 2008.
