2007 SCSU VOLLEYBALL NEWS Release Date: September 10, 2007

HALENBECK RETURN: The Husky volleyball team returns home for a non-conference match against Bemidji State University on Tuesday, Sept. 11, in Halenbeck Hall. The first serve is scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

2007 RECORD: SCSU volleyball is currently 5-6 overall in 2007 and 0-0 in the North Central Conference.



BSU OUTLOOK: Bemidji State brings a 2-4 record into tomorrow's match with a 0-2 mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. SCSU leads the all-time series with BSU, 35-14. The Beavers are coached by first year head coach Laurie Bitter.

ONE LAST RETURN TO THE NCC: SCSU volleyball enters into North Central Conference play on Saturday, Sept. 15, for the last season. The 2007-08 season marks the final year of league competition in the NCC. The Huskies will face No. 17 Augustana College at 5 p.m. in Elmen Center.



AUGIE OUTLOOK: Augustana College was recently ranked No. 17 in the AVCA poll on Sept. 3, 2007. Augie is currently 10-2 overall and is 0-0 in the North Central Conference and led by 12th-year head coach Kim Sudbeck. The Vikings lead the all-time series with the Huskies, 33-16.

2007 NCC PRESEASON PICKS: The 2007 NCC Preseason Volleyball Coaches Poll was released on August 15 and picked the SCSU Huskies to finish in seventh place after receiving nine votes. Minnesota Duluth was picked to four-peat as the NCC Champions after

gathering five of the seven first place votes and 47 total points.

CLOSING IN ON 1,000: SCSU's junior libero Andreea Pieper is closing in on 1,000 career digs. The Williams native currently has 863 digs in 249 games played and she is averaging 5.29 digs per game in 2007.

WATERMAN WAYS: First year setter Jennifer Waterman has dished out 412 set assists in 41 games played this season. The first year single season school record for assists is 859, which was set by Rachael Olson (1996-00) in 1997.

SCSU HEAD COACH PATRICIA MICKOW: Patricia Mickow is in her fifth season at St. Cloud State University during the 2007 stint. In just her second season at SCSU in 2004, Mickow guided the Huskies to the NCAA Division II tournament for the first time since 1995. The Huskies placed third in the always rugged North Central Conference that season and also gained a solid 19-12 overall record under Mickow's direction. In her fifth year at SCSU, Mickow owns a 51-80 record and in her college coaching career of 19 seasons, Mickow owns a 294-340 record.

The two-time team captain was fortunate enough to experience SDSU's move from Division II to Division I, and during her senior season in 2004, Bostrom was named to the Division I All-Independent Conference team. Bostrom currently resides in St. Cloud and plans to pursue a master's degree in sport management at St. Cloud State University.

LAST WEEK'S RESULTS: St. Paul, Minn. -- Last week, the No. 3-ranked Concordia-St. Paul Golden Bears (9-0, 0-0 NSIC) topped the Huskies in four games (19-30, 17-30, 30-28, 13-30) on Tuesday, Sept. 4, in Gangelhoff Center.

On the evening, junior Emily Baldwin (Savage) had a personal career high 62 attack attempts in four games. First year setter Jennifer Waterman (Andover) completed the match with 34 set assists and junior libero Andreaana Pieper (Williams) finished the match with a season-high 26 defensive digs.

PIEPER LEADING THE WAY: SCSU's Andreaana Pieper is on a roll defensively for the Huskies in 2007. The junior libero has 217 digs on the season and leads the North Central Conference with 5.29 digs per game. The Williams native ranks ninth on the SCSU all-time digs list with 863 career digs and is second on the school all-time digs per game list with 3.47 dpg in 249 career games played.

NCC CELEBRATING THE HISTORY 1921 2008 ST. CLOUD STATE AND THE NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008.

The North Central Conference distinguished itself as one of the premier NCAA Division II leagues in the country. The first official competition of the league was held in the spring of 1922. The founding members were South Dakota State College, College of St. Thomas, Des Moines University, Creighton University, North Dakota Agricultural College, University of North Dakota and Morningside College.

The league began to change in 2000 when Morningside elected to leave the conference. Northern Colorado (2003), followed by North Dakota State and South Dakota State (2004), elected to move up a classification to NCAA Division II. Minnesota Duluth joined the NCC in 2004 making it a seven team league.

The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 1990, 1991, 1993, 1994, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991).

The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 1987, 1988, 1990, 1991), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
