## 2007 SCSU VOLLEYBALL NEWS Release Date: September 17, 2007

**THIS WEEK'S SCHEDULE:** The Husky volleyball team returns home for a non-conference match against Winona State University on Tuesday, Sept. 18, in Halenbeck Hall. The Huskies look to snap a five-game slide, with the first serve scheduled for 7:00 p.m. SCSU will then make a road trip to the University of South Dakota and Nebraska-Omaha on Sept. 21-22. The Huskies face USD on Friday, Sept. 21, in the DakotaDome for an NCC match at 7 p.m. SCSU will complete this week's competition with match against NCC opponent Nebraska-Omaha on Saturday, Sept. 22, at 6:00 p.m. in the Sapp Fieldhouse.

**2007 RECORD:** SCSU volleyball is currently 5-8 overall in 2007 and 0-1 in the North Central Conference.



**WSU OUTLOOK:** Winona State is off to an 8-4 start in 2007, with a 2-1 mark in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. SCSU leads the all-time series with WSU, 34-7.

The Warriors, who are coached by sixth-year head coach Connie Mettille, were victorious in the last meeting between the two squads on Sept. 27, 2006, three games to one.



**USD OUTLOOK:** South Dakota (14-1, 0-1 NCC) started the 2007 season 14-0 overall before falling to No. 13 Augustana College in

the Coyotes North Central Conference season opener this past weekend. SCSU leads the all-time series 31-11, which dates back to 1979. The Coyotes defeated the Huskies in the last meeting between the two teams on Nov. 3, 2006, three games to two.



**UNO OUTLOOK:** Nebraska-Omaha was recently ranked No. 14 in the AVCA poll released on Sept. 10, 2007. The Mavericks are 7-4 overall and 0-2 in

the NCC. UNO leads the all-time series with the Huskies, 41-13, as the Mavericks defeated SCSU in the last meeting, 3-0 (11/4/06).

**THE ROAD TO 1,000:** SCSU's junior libero Andrea Pieper is closing in on 1,000 career digs. The Williams native currently has 921 digs in 256 games played and she is averaging 5.73 digs per game in 2007, which leads the North Central Conference.

**SCSU HEAD COACH PATRICIA MICKOW:** Patricia Mickow is in her fifth season at St. Cloud State University during the 2007 stint. In just her second season at SCSU in 2004, Mickow guided the Huskies to the NCAA Division II tournament for the first time since 1995. The Huskies placed third in the always rugged North Central Conference that season and also gained a solid 19-12 overall record under Mickow's direction. In her fifth year at SCSU, Mickow owns a 51-82 record and in her college coaching career of 19 seasons, Mickow owns a 294-342 record.

ASSISTING IN 2007: Aaron Nelson was appointed the assistant volleyball coach in the spring of 2007. An Austin, Minn. native, Nelson attended nearby Sauk Rapids High School. Most recently, he has been an 'A' head coach for the Nebraska Elite Junior Olympic Volleyball program in Omaha, Nebraska. He brings 15 years of volleyball coaching experience to the Huskies. Nelson was a volunteer assistant coach with the St. Cloud State volleyball program in 1998, 1999, and 2000, with then head coach Dianne Glowatzke. Nelson earned both a bachelor's in 1996 and master's degree in 2001 from St. Cloud State.

Kimberly Bostrom joins the Husky coaching staff in 2007 for the first time as a graduate assistant coach. Originally from Lino Lakes, Minn., Bostrom is a 2001 graduate from Centennial High School in Circle Pines, Minn. Bostrom went on to play collegiate volleyball at South Dakota State University from 2001-2004. The two-time team captain was fortunate enough to experience SDSU's move from Division II to Division I, and during her senior season in 2004, Bostrom was named to the Division I All-Independent Conference team. Bostrom currently resides in St. Cloud and plans to pursue a master's degree in sport management at St. Cloud State University.

COACH DANIELLE KOHUT: Danielle Kohut returns to the Husky volleyball program as a volunteer assistant coach in 2007. Kohut was a defensive specialist and a setter on the Husky volleyball squad from 2003-2005 under the helm of current head coach Patricia Mickow. The Hafford, Sask., native began her collegiate volleyball career at Williston State in 2001 and played there for two seasons before transferring to SCSU in 2003. LAST WEEK'S RESULTS: The Huskies tallied a team season high 100 digs against Bemidji State University on Sept. 11, 2007, in Halenbeck Hall. Junior libero Andreaana Pieper (Williams) accounted for 30 of those digs against the BSU Beavers, which also marked an individual season high in 2007.

On Saturday, Sept. 15, the Huskies dropped a tough match to No. 13 Augustana College to open up 2007 North Central Conference play. The Huskies lost the match in three games by scores of 26-30, 28-30, and 22-30.

On the night the Huskies were once again led offensively by Emily Baldwin (Savage) who finished with a match high 18 kills and 55 total attacks. Also for the Huskies, Ashley Shields (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) finished with 16 kills and a hitting percentage of .289. On the defensive side, Andreaana Pieper (Williams) collected a match high 28 digs, sending her over the 900 mark for her career at 921. Jennifer Waterman (Andover) also added 41 set assists in the campaign.

ON THE WAY UP: Jennifer Waterman (Andover), SCSU's first year setter, has moved up to 12th on the SCSU all-time career assists list with 457 set assists in 45 games played (10.16 apg).

YIELD FOR SHIELDS: Husky first year outside hitter Ashley Shields (Whitefish Bay, Wis.) currently ranks 11th on the all-time school list with 2.91 kills per game in 44 games played. Shields ranks second on the team with 128 kills in 2007.



ST. CLOUD STATE AND THE NORTH CENTRAL CONFERENCE

The 2007-08 school year will mark the final year of league competition in the North Central

Conference for the St. Cloud State University athletics program. St. Cloud State University, Minnesota State University Mankato, Augustana College and the University of Minnesota Duluth will join the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference in the fall of 2008. The University of Nebraska-Omaha will join the Mid-America Intercollegiate Athletics Association, while the University of South Dakota and the University of North Dakota have elected to seek NCAA Division I status.

The St. Cloud State men's program joined the North Central Conference in 1981. The Huskies made their presence known in the league winning 13 tennis championships (1986, 1990, 1991, 1993, 1994, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006) four swimming and diving championships (1982, 83, 84, 85), four basketball championships (1986, 87, 88, 2001), three golf championships, two football (1989 and 2002), and one title each in cross-country (1983), and baseball (1991).

The SCSU women's program joined the NCC in 1984, and won five conference tennis titles (1985, 1987, 1988, 1990, 1991), three softball titles (1998, 2003, 2004), and one basketball championship (1989).
