2006 SCSU VOLLEYBALL NEWS

Release Date: Sept. 18, 2006



HUSKY HOME STAND CONTINUES: The St. Cloud State University volleyball team (4-9, 0-1 NCC) will play three more matches at home this week. On Tuesday, Sept. 19, the Huskies play host to non-conference opponent Minnesota Crookston (4-13, 0-5 NSIC) at 7:00 p.m. in Halenbeck Hall. SCSU returns to NCC action on Friday, Sept 22, with a match against Minnesota State Mankato at 7:00 p.m. The Huskies will round out the week's play with a 4:00 p.m. NCC tilt against Augustana on Saturday, Sept. 23, in Halenbeck Hall.

KVSC 88.1 FM: The Husky volleyball team can be heard live on KVSC 88.1 FM on Tuesday, Sept. 19, against Minnesota Crookston. Ben Bardsen will handle the play-by-play and Eric Aadlund will provide color commentary.

NOWAK AND PANGRAC EARN NCC HONORS: SCSU's **Kristi Pangrac** (Upsala) and **Sierra Nowak** (Marshfield, Wisc.) earned North Central Conference Player of the Week honors this week. Pangrac, who shares the honor with Minnesota Duluth's Vicky Braegelmann, hit .327 (46k-14e-98ta) while averaging 3.83 kills per game in three matches last week. Nowak, who was named the Co-Setter of the Week (shares with Minnesota Duluth's Katie Gangelhoff), averaged 12.75 assists per game while hitting .267 (11k-3e-30ta) in three matches last week.



Gothe

NINE IS FINE: Husky senior outside hitter and co-captain, **Lindsey Gothe** (Elk River, SCSU), recently etched her name into the top ten all-time digs list at St. Cloud State University. Last week alone, Gothe tallied 43 digs and now has 855 career digs at SCSU, which is good for ninth place on the all-time list. In 2006, Gothe has collected a team-best 154 digs and 184 kills in the front row.

GOLDEN EAGLE'S OUTLOOK: The Minnesota Crookston Golden Eagles are off to a 4-13 overall record and a 0-5 record in the NSIC. Coached by Dave Simon, who is in his seventh season at UM-Crookston, the Golden Eagles are led by senior middle hitter Erin Flynn (Bloomer, Wisc.) and junior middle hitter Theresa Crance (Timberlake, SD). In 54 games played, Flynn leads the team with 227 kills (4.20/game) and a .335 hitting percentage. Crance is second on the team with 143 kills (2.70/game) and a .182 hitting percentage. Sophomore setter Cassie Yates (Buffalo) leads UM-Crookston with 531 set assists.



SCSU RETURNS TO NCC PLAY AGAINST MSU, MANKATO: Minnesota State University Mankato has posted a 10-4 overall record in 2006 and is 1-0 in the NCC (as of Sept. 18, 2006). The Mavericks have been led by sophomore outside hitter Ashley Nachreiner (Round Rock, Tex.), who has totaled 137 hits (2.98/game). Another outside hitter, senior Cassie Wolpern, is second on the team with 123 hits in 2006.

Running the offense this year has been junior setter Stef Sandstrom (Andover). In 50 games played, Sandstrom has dished out 549 set assists and is third in the NCC with 10.98 assists per game.



AUGIE OUTLOOK: Augustana is 6-7 overall in 2006 and is off to a 1-0 start in the NCC. Junior setter Jenna Lago (Ankeny, Iowa) has directed the Viking's attack with 531 set assists. Senior middle hitters Andrea Oswald (Pilger, Neb.) and Terrin Post (Prinsburg) lead AC with 427 combined kills this season. In the NCC, Oswald is sixth with a .301 overall hitting percentage and ranks second with 4.56 kills per game. Post ranks seventh in the NCC with 3.35 kills per game.



Mickow

SCSU HEAD COACH PATRICIA MICKOW: Patricia Mickow is in her fourth season at St. Cloud State University during the 2006 season. In just her second season at SCSU in 2004, Mickow guided the Huskies to the NCAA Division II tournament for the first time since 1995. The Huskies placed third in the always rugged North Central Conference that season and also gained a solid 19-12 overall record under Mickow's direction. In her fourth year at SCSU, Mickow owns a 42-61 record and in her college coaching career of 18 seasons, Mickow owns a 285-321 record.

ASSISTANT COACH:



ASSISTING IN 2006: Jenifer Odette is in her 12th season as an assistant coach with the Huskies. Her responsibilities as the Huskies' top assistant include being the lead recruiter and running the strength and conditioning program. She works primarily with the middle and right side hitters. Odette played volleyball at North Dakota State University from 1984 to 1987 as a right side hitter. In her senior season

Odette NDSU posted a 44-8 record. She was an All-Conference, All-Region and All-American selection as a senior and in 1986 the Bison advanced to the NCAA Division II Final Four.

2006 NCC PRESEASON PICKS: The 2006 NCC Preseason Volleyball Coaches Poll was released on August 15 and picked the SCSU Huskies to finish in fifth place in a tie with North Dakota after both teams received 19 votes in the poll. Minnesota Duluth was picked to three-peat as the NCC Champions after gathering six of the seven first-place votes and totaling 48 points.

TEAM CAPTAINS: Senior outside hitter Lindsey Gothe (Elk River, South Dakota State transfer), senior setter Sierra Nowak (Marshfield, Wis.) and senior middle hitter Deanna Pieper (Williams) will share the team's captain responsibilities for the 2006 season.

2005 RECORD: The SCSU Huskies finished the 2005 season with an 8-21 overall record and a seventh place finish in the North Central Conference with a 2-10 record. Graduating senior Angie Mayers was named to the 2005 All-NCC team and Jamie Schlagel, another graduating senior, was named to the 2005 All-NCC Honorable Mention team.

MINNESOTA CROOKSTON'S HEAD COACH DAVE SIMON: Minnesota Crookston's volleyball team has been coached by Dave Simon since 2000. A native of Crookston, Dave Simon returned to Crookston from the University of Wyoming. At the U of Wyoming he was the top assistant under Coach Susan Judge for the 1997-2000 seasons. Simon is assisted by Amanda Neubauer and Wayne Folkers.

AUGIE'S HEAD COACH KIM SUDBECK:

Head coach Kim Sudbeck is in her 11th season at Augustana College with a career coaching record of 238-85. The winningest coach in Viking volleyball history, she has guided the Vikings to four North Central Conference titles, eight appearances in the NCAA Division II region playoffs in the last nine years, one North Central Region Championship and the school's first appearance in the Elite Eight where Augustana finished as the national runner-up in 2000. In 2006, Sudbeck is assisted by Stacie Busse-Remme and Lindsey Taatjes.



Amundson

DENNIS AMUNDSON, MINNESOTA STATE'S HEAD COACH:

The Minnesota State University Mavericks have tallied a 10-4 overall record in 2006 under the leadership of third-year head coach Dennis Amundson. Amundson came to MSU after spending the 2004 season as an assistant coach at the University of St. Thomas. In 2006, Amundson is assisted by Heather Bitz, Jamie Skadeland and Lori Rittenhouse.

ASSIST TO NOWAK: SCSU's senior setter and co-captain Sierra Nowak (Marshfield, Wisc.) has tallied 602 set assists in 2006 alone and has

1,113 total career set assists at SCSU. Recently, she dished out 64 set assists against Winona State, which marks the most set assists in a game personally for Nowak in her career. The Huskies totaled 73 set assists against WSU, which marks the most set assists in a game in 2006 for the Huskies. In the NCC, Nowak currently ranks second with 11.80 set assists per game.



Pangrac

PANGRAC POUNDING AWAY: SCSU's junior right side hitter Kristi Pangrac (Upsala) leads the Huskies with a .300 overall hitting percentage and is second on the team with 167 kills in 2006. In the NCC, Pangrac ranks eighth with 3.27 kills per game. Just this past week, Pangrac totaled 46 kills (.327) in three games played and helped the Huskies gain two more victories on the season.
