2010 SCSU VOLLEYBALL NEWS Final Release Date: December 13, 2010

HUSKY SEASON COMES TO A CLOSE:

St. Cloud State ended its third season in the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference with a 3-0 sweep over Northern State University on Nov. 13 to complete the season at an even .500 record of 14-14 overall. SCSU improved from a 12th place finish in the league last season (2009) to place eighth in the ever-gruelling NSIC with a 9-11 mark in 2010.

2010 RECORD: The Huskies navigated through a difficult slate of games in 2010 that included 11 matches against nationally ranked opponents by finishing 14-14. Five of those 11 matches were against the nation's No. 1-ranked teams during that week. SCSU's all-time record now stands at 689-599 (.535) since 1969.

SIX IS BLISS: The Huskies posted their best season in six years under the helm of first year head coach Michelle Blaeser. The last time SCSU posted more than ten victories in a season was back in 2004 when the Huskies appeared in the NCAA Division II tournament, completing the season 19-12 overall and 7-5 in the North Central Conference.

RANKED IN THE REGION: For the first time since the 2004 season, the St. Cloud State volleyball team cracked the top-ten in the Central Region poll. Under the direction of first year head coach Michelle Blaeser, the Huskies were ranked tenth in the region for two consecutive weeks. The NSIC sported the top-five teams in the region and six of the top-ten.

NSIC FALL ACADEMIC HONOREES: Erica Beacom (Elkhorn, Neb.), Chelsea Nagle (Preston) and Kayla Tschida (Upsala) earned the NSIC Fall Academic honor from SCSU's volleyball team.

To be eligible for this honor, the student-athlete must be a member of the varsity traveling team and have a cumulative grade point average of 3.20 or better. Furthermore, The athlete must have reached sophomore athletic and academic standing at her/his institution (true freshmen, red-shirt freshmen and ineligible athletic transfers are not eligible) and must have completed at least one full academic year at that institution.

SENIOR SALUTE: The Huskies say good bye to their two seniors in Kayla Tschida (Upsala) and Ashley Shields (Milwaukee, Wis.).

THE NSIC: Without question, the Huskies play in the toughest Division II volleyball conference in the land...the Northern Sun Intercollegiate Conference. Housing the last three straight National Championships by Concordia-St. Paul, the NSIC consistently had five of its 14 teams ranked in the AVCA Top-25 weekly poll throughout the 2010 season.

UNDEFEATED IN LEAGUE ACTION: For the first time as an NSIC affiliate, the Huskies started the 2010 stint undefeated in league competition at 2-0 with wins over U-Mary (3-0) and Northern State (3-2). The last time St. Cloud State started

a season off undefeated in conference action was in 1995, when the Huskies went 4-0 to begin North Central Conference competition.

HIGH FIVE: St. Cloud State jump-started its NSIC schedule with a 4-1 mark. The last time the Huskies suffered just one loss in their first five league matches played was back in 1995 when SCSU started off the North Central Conference season 4-1. SCSU went on to tab a 14-4 mark in the NCC under the helm of then SCSU head coach Dianne Glowatzke in 1995.



Shields

JOIN THE CLUB: St. Cloud State's senior outside hitter Ashley Shields (Milwaukee, Wis.) put away her 1,000th career kill in a big 3-1 Husky victory over Winona State University on Friday, Oct. 8, at WSU's McCown Gymnasium. Shields, who totaled 12 kills and had no errors in the match, is just the 11th Husky in school history to accomplish this feat. She leaves SCSU ranking ninth all-time with 1,117 kills.



Tschida

ALL-NSIC HONORS: SCSU's senior middle hitter Kayla Tschida led the NSIC for most of the season in the overall blocks category, averaging 1.18 blocks per set for a total of 107.0 (15s, 92a) in 2010. For her efforts she landed on the All-NSIC Honorable Mention squad. Tschida completed the season ranked second behind Minnesota Duluth's Alyssa Nelson, who edged Tschida, averaging 1.19 blocks per set.

AMONG THE NATION'S BEST: St. Cloud State's Kayla Tschida (Upsala) completed her senior stint ranked 19th in the nation, averaging 1.18 blocks per set in 2010. As a team, the Huskies led the NSIC for a majority of the season and finished the 2010 stint second in the league behind nationally ranked Minnesota Duluth with an average of 2.17 blocks per set. SCSU's 42 solo blocks and 359 block assists ranked 30th in the nation at the Division II level.

BEACOM EARNS ACADEMIC NOD: Junior volleyball player Erica Beacom (Elkhorn, Neb.) landed on the ESPN Academic All-District Five College Division Third Team as voted on by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). To be nominated for this academic award, the student-athlete must be a starter or important reserve with at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average at her current institution. Beacom is an anthropology major at St. Cloud State, sporting a 3.77 grade point average. In 28 matches played in 2010, Beacom put away 155 kills and totaled 41 blocks (3s, 38a) on the right side.

Blaeser

HEAD COACH MICHELLE BLAESER: On March 4, 2010, Michelle Blaeser was named the fourth head volleyball coach in school history. Just two days after becoming the Husky coach, Blaeser was bound for Denver to recruit at the Colorado Qualifier and she hasn't stopped since. A St. Cloud native, and Technical High School graduate, Blaeser brings 20 years of coaching experience, including 18 years at the collegiate level, and ten years as a head coach to the Husky program. Since 2000, Blaeser had been the head volleyball coach at nearby College of St. Benedict where she also served as an assistant athletic director and compliance director. During Blaeser's stint at CSB she advanced the St. Ben's Blazers to the NCAA Division II Tournament four out of the last five seasons, including an Elite Eight appearance in 2008. Named the 2009 MIAC Coach of the Year, Blaeser's CSB teams ranked in the top-25 of the AVCA poll all ten years of her tenure with the Blazers. She has also coached four All-Americans and ten All-Region Players. After leading SCSU to its most successful season in six years at 14-14, Blaeser has compiled a 201-123 overall win/loss record in 11 years.



Peniata

ASSISTANT COACH MARCI PENIATA: Malama (Marci) Alofa Peniata was named the volleyball assistant coach, effective July 1, 2010. Marci Peniata spent the last three seasons as the second assistant coach for the Ball State University women's volleyball team. Prior to her tenure at Ball State, Peniata was a four-year member of the University of Minnesota Golden Gophers women's volleyball team. Peniata, who earned her bachelor's degree in business in 2007, finished her career at Minnesota (2003-06) ranked second on the school's all-time career digs list at 1,401. After leading the Big Ten with a 5.22 digs-per-game average her senior season, Peniata earned American Volleyball Coaches Association All-America Honorable Mention accolades, was named the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Year and was a First-Team All-Big Ten honoree. She was also a four-time Scholar Athlete and garnered the Big Ten Defensive Player of the Week accolades three times during her collegiate stint.



Kohut

COACH DANIELLE KOHUT: Danielle Kohut returned to the Husky volleyball program for her second season as a graduate assistant coach in 2010. No stranger to the program, Kohut served as a volunteer assistant coach in 2007 and also was a defensive specialist and a setter on the Husky volleyball squad from 2003-05 under the helm of current head coach Patricia Gerchy (Mickow). The Hafford, Sask., native began her collegiate volleyball career at Williston State in 2001 and played there for two seasons before transferring to SCSU in 2003. During her stint at Williston State, Kohut gained MVP honors in 2002 as the team's starting setter. That squad went on to win the conference championship. Following her playing days, Kohut returned to Williston State in 2005 as an assistant volleyball coach. Her first season in coaching, Kohut helped lead her team to a conference championship and a regional championship. The following season in 2006, Williston State captured the regional's championship, was ranked as high as 15th in the nation, and advanced to the national tournament held in Scottsdale, Ariz. After graduating from St. Cloud State in 2007, she worked as a physical therapist at the Victoria Hospital in Prince Albert, Saskatchewan. Kohut is pursuing a graduate degree in sports management.

#1 CHELSEA NAGLE: Nagle appeared in 101 sets for the Huskies in 2010...the junior libero was voted the team's Best Defensive Player after leading the Huskies with 481 digs...

#3 ALICIA VOSSEN: Vossen saw action in 20 sets for the Huskies during her rookie stint in 2010. The Minnetonka native put away a career-high five kills at Bemidji State on Oct. 23...

#4 LAUREN CIPPERLY: Cipperly charted ten matches with double digit kills in 2010...in 96 sets played, the sophomore outside hitter totaled 198 kills (.082), 29 set assists and 34 total blocks (3s, 31a)...

#5 JORDAN HANSEN: Stepped in as a first year player in the back row...co-let the squad with 27 serving aces in her rookie season debut...charted a career-high four serving aces at Augustana College on Oct. 29...

#7 JEN WATERMAN: Had a sensational season after taking a medical red-shirt season in 2009...led the team with 975 assists during her junior stint...team tri-captain...dished out a season-best 54 assists at Winona State in a huge 3-1 NSIC road victory...

A BRIEF HISTORY OF THE NORTHERN SUN INTERCOLLEGIATE CONFERENCE

Since 1932, various institutions have competed in the NSIC. Bemidji State University, Minnesota State University Moorhead and Winona State University are charter members and have remained in the conference for the 76 years of its existence.

Minnesota State University, Mankato and St. Cloud State were also charter members, but left the league in 1981 (MSU left the league in 1969 and returned in 1977). The University of Minnesota Duluth, which departed the league in 2005-06 through 2007-08 seasons, was also an original member.

Other current members joined in later years: Southwest Minnesota State University in 1969, Northern State University in 1978, Wayne State College (Nebraska) in 1998, Concordia University, St. Paul and the University of Minnesota, Crookston in 1999, the University of Mary and Upper Iowa University in 2006 and Augustana College in 2008. The University of Minnesota, Morris became a league member in 1966, however, the Cougars opted for the NCAA Division III ranks in 2003. Michigan Tech was also a part of NIC from 1969 to 1977 as well.
