2007-08 SCSU WRESTLING TEAM NEWS

HUSKIES END SEASON 12TH AT DIVISION II NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS: Two years ago SCSU was wrapping up an 0-8 dual season and were without a representative at the National Tournament. Fast forward to the present, as St. Cloud State can now be called one of the country's best. The SCSU grapplers recently completed its 2007-08 campaign by sending seven wrestlers to the NCAA Division II National Championships, taking home a 12th place finish.



The seven student-athletes that qualified for the tournament were: Josh Williams (133 lbs. / Banks, Ore.), Gabe Suarez (141 lbs. / Las Vegas, Nev.), John Sundgren (157 lbs. / Blaine), Tom Anderson (165 lbs. / Belview), Derek Skala (174 lbs. / Owatonna), Brad Padgett (184 lbs. / Buckley, Wash.) and Nick Wilkes (197 lbs. / Onamia).

The sixth-ranked Padgett led all Husky wrestlers at the tournament by earning a fourth place finish. Padgett went 4-2, falling in the third place match by a narrow 5-4 count to #1 Jared Deaguero. #8 Wilkes was the second of three wrestlers to make it to Day Two, recording a sixth place finish by going 3-3, and #8 Sundgren rounded out the Husky placers, taking home eighth place honors.

Williams and Skala earned team points by winning one match apiece. Both wrestlers went 1-2 on the tournament, both winning their second match.

Suarez and Anderson both ended successful seasons at the tournament, both going 0-2. Suarez, a redshirt freshman, finished the season 32-6, while Anderson finished his collegiate career with his first appearance at the National Tournament.

SUNDGREN NAMED FIRST TEAM ALL-DIVISION II ACADEMIC TEAM: John Sundgren was named to the First Team while Westy Hanson and Matt Jackson earned Honorable Mentions to the NCAA Division II All-Academic Wrestling Team it was announced recently. As a team, the Huskies finished with the eighth best overall mark with a 3.219 GPA. Sundgren, a redshirt freshman from Blaine, is undecided on a major and has accumulated a 3.48 GPA. Hanson is a sophomore education major from Crookston, earning an Honorable Mention by putting up a 3.70 GPA. Jackson rounds out SCSU's individual honorees as he also earned an Honorable Mention for his work in the classroom. Jackson, a junior from Oakdale, has built 3.85 GPA as a Math major.

HEAD COACH STEVE COSTANZO:



Steve Costanzo finishes his second season as head wrestling coach at St. Cloud State. He is the 13th coach in the 58-year history of the program and begins his ninth season overall as a head coach. He has an overall record of 78-39-2 while coaching 82 National Qualifiers, 34 All-Americans and 2 National Champions at Dana College in Blair, Neb. and here at SCSU.

In Costanzo's first season, the Huskies finished with a 4-7 dual record, qualifying Nick Wilkes for the Division II National Championships. SCSU ranked 14th nationally with a 3.029 GPA as Tom Messerli, Tom Anderson, Adam Hill and Matt Jackson were named to the Division II All Academic Team.

Prior to coming to the Granite City, Costanzo spent seven seasons at Dana College in Blair, Neb. where he led the 2006 squad to NAIA tourney and dual national championships. Costanzo's teams improved their dual record every

year he was with the program, as he accumulated a 61-30-2 record. Costanzo's success earned him NWCA and NAIA Coach of the Year honors in 2006 along with Region Coach of the Year honors in 2005 and 2006.

Costanzo's recruiting squads while at Dana College, recognized by Wrestling USA Magazine, finished 15th in 2001, 4th in 2004 and 1st in 2005 for non-NCAA Division I programs. Costanzo's 2006 SCSU class recorded the tenth spot in that same publication for non-NCAA Division I programs. This past summer, Costanzo's coaching staff was recognized by InterMat as having one of the top NCAA Division II recruiting classes for 2007.

Costanzo graduated from the University of Nebraska-Omaha in 1996 where he was a three-time All-American. He finished his career fifth on the all-time wins list at UNO after winning NCC Championships in 1994 and 1995. His decorated career earned him a place in the Nebraska Wrestling Hall of Fame, to which he was inducted in 2006.

Costanzo is currently pursuing his Masters Degree through Emporia State studying physical education. He and his wife Nancy have four children: Cassandra, Sam, Katie and Brock.

HUSKY WRESTLING ENJOYS BEST SEASON IN OVER 35 YEARS: In year two of the Steve Costanzo era, things appear to be turning around for the Husky Wrestling Program. After just two dual wins in the last four non-Costanzo years, the Huskies rattled off a 13-2 dual mark, the most W's since 1972-73, and fifth-most in the 58-year history of Husky Wrestling.

SHUT-OUT CITY: Within SCSU's 13 wins this season, came two impressive shut-outs against Wisconsin-Eau Claire and SW Minnesota State. Jan. 11 the Huskies blanked the BluGolds 42-0, the first Husky shutout since the 1983-84 season when the State grapplers defeated Minnesota Morris 48-0. After 24 seasons without running the table against an opponent, the Huskies matched the feat just three weeks later, when they won all 10 matches in a 50-0 romp over the Mustangs. The 50-point margin of victory was the largest in the storied history of Husky Wrestling.

SUAREZ SHINES IN FIRST YEAR: The 2007-08 Husky Wrestling team had an excellent mix of youth and veteran leadership, and nowhere was that more apparent than at 141 lbs. with Gabe Suarez. Suarez, a redshirt freshman and redshirt wrestler of the year in 2006-07, was second on the team in victories with 32, while posting just six losses. Suarez was also 15-0 in duals en route to a second place finish in the North Regions, earning him a spot in the Division II Wrestling Championships.

LAST HURRAH FOR HUSKY SENIORS: Four Husky seniors wrestled for the final time this season, as the group was honored in the last home match against Upper Iowa. Matt Steffenson (Onamia), Jairo Sandoval (Miami, Fla.), Tom Anderson (Belviw) and Nick Wilkes (Onamia) all donned the SCSU cardinal, black and white for the final time this season.

SPEAKING OF SENIORS....: Tom Anderson and Nick Wilkes both went out on high notes, as the two qualified for the Division II Championships in Cedar Rapids, Iowa. Anderson earned his first trip in his final year by getting fourth in the North Region, before dropping his first two matches in the Hawkeye State. Anderson had by far his best collegiate season, compiling a 27-19 record that more than doubled his career win total (11) from his first three seasons.

Wilkes had as good of a two-year run as anybody in the SCSU program, going 46-16 and qualifying for two NCAA Division II Tournaments. Wilkes took second in the regional en route to a sixth place finish and All-America honors at this year's D-II Championships, improving on a fourth-place regional and two-and-out showing last season.

STREAKING HUSKIES: The Huskies eight-dual win streak to start the season set the tone for much of the success in 2007-08. The eight-dual run was the longest since the 1980-81 season when SCSU rattled off another eight victories, en route to a 12-2 year.

TOURNAMENT TERRORS: The North Region culminated a season-long run of successful tournaments and open's for SCSU. Six different wrestlers captured first place in a tournament this year, as the Huskies traveled to Moorhead for the Cobber and Dragon Opens and to Indianapolis for the traditionally strong Midwest Classic. Included in the Husky winners circle was Nolan Boucher (Cobber Open / Hwt.), Jacob Horn (Dragon Open / 141 lbs.), Brad Padgett (Dragon Open, North Regions / 184 lbs.), Gabe Suarez (Cobber Open / 141 lbs.), John Sundgren (Cobber Open / 157 lbs.), and Josh Williams (Cobber Open / 133 lbs.).

ASSISTANT COACHES

Graduate Assistant Matt Lowers

Lowers, a first year coach, is a native of Wadena, MN where he was an All-State athlete while competing in wrestling, football, track and field and for Wadena-Deer Creek High School. After suffering a severe neck and back injury in high school, Matt ended up attending Concordia College where he graduated in 2006 with a degree in Exercise Science and a minor in coaching.

Lowers joins the SCSU coaching staff after serving the past two years as an assistant with the 2007 National Champion University of Minnesota Wrestling team. Matt joined the Gophers in 2006 when the team captured the Division I National Dual Team Championship, Big Ten Championship and finished second at the NCAA's. In 2007 the Minnesota Wrestling team repeated as National Dual and Big Ten Champions and also won the NCAA's for the third time in school history. While also serving as an assistant with the University of MN wrestling team Matt worked as the Director of Wrestling Operations for J Robinson Intensive Camps. J Robinson Intensive Camps have set the standard for Intensive camps while training over 3000 athletes each summer.

Graduate Assistant Severin Walsh

Walsh, in his second season with SCSU, is a native of Coulee City, WA where he captured the 1995 Washington High School State Championship for Almira/Coulee-Hartline High School. He began his collegiate career at Yakima Valley Community College then transferred to William Penn University where he was a 2002 NAIA National Qualifier and 2002 Central Region Champion for the Statesmen.

As a coach, Walsh helped lead William Penn University to the 2003 and 2004 NAIA Central Region Championships. He also helped lead the Statesmen to a sixth place finish at the 2003 NAIA National Championships and a ninth place finish at the 2004 NAIA National Championships. After the 2003-04 season at Penn, Walsh coached at NAIA rival Dana College and helped the Vikings reclaim their Regional title with back-to-back Regional Championships in 2005 and 2006. In addition, he helped lead the Vikings to their first ever National Championship in 2006.

Volunteer Jeremy Lang

Lang, a second-year volunteer, is a native of Springfield, MN and a 1993 graduate of Springfield High School. He was a five-year letter-winner in wrestling, three-time Minnesota High School state qualifier and a three-time All-State recipient in wrestling and placed fifth at state his senior year. He amassed a career high school record of 101-36-2. Competed for the Huskies from 1993-99, Lang was a three-year letterwinner for SCSU and a three-time All-Conference recipient in the tough North Central Conference.

Volunteer Student Coach Tom Messerli

Messerli, first-year volunteer, is a native of Lafayette, MN and a 2003 graduate of Gibbons/Fairfax/Winthrop High School. He lettered five times in wrestling and posted a career record of 98-42. Competed for the Huskies from 2003-07, Messerli was a three-year letterwinner for SCSU and a three-time NWCA All-Academic recipient. In 2006, Messerli was voted the Dean Weisman Wrestler of the Year for Husky wrestling. Messerli resides in St. Cloud and will be completing his degree in finance this year.
