HUSKIES HEADLINERS:

- The #1 ranked Huskies (14-0, 2-0- NSIC) will travel to non-conference rival Concordia-Moorhead on Friday, Jan. 20 for a 7 p.m. match. SCSU will complete the weekend on Jan. 21 with a 2 p.m. dual match at NSIC rival Minnesota State, Moorhead.
- The #1 Huskies capped a three-win week on Jan. 18 with a big 41-3 win over UW-Eau Claire at Halenbeck Hall. This was SCSU's dual match home opener for the 2011-12 season. On Jan. 13, the Huskies opened the NSIC dual season with a 23-19 victory at Northern State and they completed the weekend with a 28-12 win at Mary on Jan. 15. The Huskies have won 19 consecutive dual matches dating back to an 18-13 loss at Augustana on Jan. 27, 2011. SCSU has not lost a home dual match since a 21-15 setback to Upper Iowa on Feb. 14, 2010. The victory over UW-Eau Claire sets a new team record for consecutive dual match wins for the Huskies. The previous record of 18 consecutive dual victories was set during the 1970-72 seasons.
- Fans should make plans now to attend the special SCSU-Southwest Minnesota State dual match on Jan. 28 at Canby High School in Canby, Minn. SCSU senior team captain Tad Merritt is a graduate of Canby H.S.
- The Huskies earned the #1 spot in the 2011-12 NSIC preseason poll. The Huskies also received the top spot in the 2011-12 preseason national poll. SCSU has moved back into the #1 spot in the latest DII coaches' poll released on Jan. 11, ahead of #2 Newberry and #3 Upper Iowa. Merritt (165) and Kahnke (285) are both ranked #1 in this week's national poll, while O'Grady (174), Skala (184) and Munkelwitz (197) are all ranked #3. Jacob D. Horn is ranked #5 at 157 in the poll this week.
- Tad Merritt leads the Huskies with 23 wins this season (23-2) and he also has 12 pins. Jake Kahnke is 22-1 this season, while Luke Munkelwitz joined the 20-win club with a 20-4 record this past weekend. Others of note include Derek Skala at 16-2 and Zach Stewart at 17-8. Josh Howk is 18-11 this year with a team-high 14 pins.
- St. Cloud State University (19-2, 6-1 NSIC) set a new team standard by capturing 2nd place at the 2011 NCAA Division II championships on March 11-12 in Kearney, Neb. This is the best finish at a national championship for the Huskies since the program started in 1949-50. The previous best efforts for the Huskies were 3rd place finishes at the NAIA tournament in 1963 and 1965. In NCAA Division II action, the best finish prior to 2011 was a 7th place finish in 2010 and 1983. SCSU scored 90.5 team points at the NCAA championships, while Nebraska-Omaha won its third consecutive team title with 102.5 points. This was the most points scored at a national meet by the Huskies in team history. The previous high was 50 points scored at the NCAA tournament in 2010.
- SCSU's John Sundgren captured 1st place at the NCAA championships in the 157-pound bracket. He was the first Husky to win a national title since Gene Hanemann won his title in 1995. This was the 12th individual national title for a Husky wrestler since 1958, and it was just the 2nd NCAA Division II individual national title for a Husky wrestler.
- The Huskies bring back the following All-Americans from the 2011 championships: Jacob Kahnke (2nd at 285), Tad Merritt (3rd at 165), Shamus O'Grady (4th at 174) and Jacob D. Horn (5th at 149). Senior Derek Skala was a redshirt last year but he has earned All-America honors at previous NCAA meets.
- The top finish at the 2012 NWCA DII National Duals was the best finish for the Huskies at that prestigious tournament. Last year, SCSU finished in third place at the NWCA DII National Duals.



SCSU COACH STEVE COSTANZO: Steve Costanzo is in his 6th season as the Husky head wrestling coach. Overall, this marks Costanzo's 13th season as a head college wrestling coach. He has a career record of 134-53-2 while coaching 106 National Qualifiers, 47 All-Americans, 3 National Champions and 46 NWCA All-Academic recipients. His record at St. Cloud State now stands at 64-23. An All-American wrestler at Nebraska-Omaha (1996 graduate), Costanza previously coached at Dana College from 1999 to 2006. Costanza led Dana to a national title in 2006, and guided SCSU to a 2nd place NCAA finish in 2011. He was assisted in 2011-12 by Brady Wilson, Tyson Reiner, Jeremy Lang, John Peterson, Brad Padgett, Gabe Suarez, Josh Joriman and Tony Mack. Student team managers are Kristine Schiller, Sonia Caputo, Stephanie Nelson and Ryan Schroper.
