Everglades National Park

The Everglades National Park is the largest subtropical wilderness area in the United States. The area boasts rare and endangered species. It has been designated a World Heritage Site, International Biosphere Reserve, and Wetland of International Importance, significant to all people of the world. This trip travels between the small barrier islands that serve as the buffer between the mangroves and the Gulf of Mexico. The lead instructors for all our programs are highly trained students with credentials from the Wilderness Education Association, American Canoe Association, Leave No Trace and American Red Cross.

Trip Details

This trip is designed for participants with beginning to intermediate outdoor experience. This trip will probably be more physically demanding than your daily existence, but it achievable with little advance preparation.
