²IM 204, IM 245 and IM 260 may be taken any time during the first four semesters. They are offered every semester. Some required courses are available during Summer Session. Additional electives available during summer session include IM 445 Children’s Literature Workshop and IM 486 Seminar (1-3 cr.). These two courses may be repeated as the content varies.
