This agreement is made this _____ day of _____, 20____, by and between the department of _____ (hereinafter referred to as the “Department”) and the Minnesota Highway Safety Center (hereinafter referred to as the “Center”).

Whereas, in order to maintain well- trained law enforcement personnel, the Department coordinates training programs for its employees in maneuvers and tactics of law enforcement; and

Whereas, the Department, as part of ongoing training programs for its personnel, is scheduling training vehicle Pursuit Intervention Tactics (“PIT” maneuvers); and

Whereas, the Center is qualified and recognized expert in “PIT” maneuvers; and

Whereas, the Department desires to engage the Center to serve as trainer in “PIT” maneuvers.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms and conditions expressed herein, the Department agrees as follows:

The Department agrees to defend, identify and hold harmless the Center, its employees from any claims, demands, costs attorneys fees, or judgment relating to the “PIT” maneuvers training, or the Departments use and implementation of Pursuit Intervention Tactics (“PIT” maneuvers), including, but not limited to, excessive force, negligent training, and negligent supervision claims.
