What is the Senior to Sophomore Program?

Senior to Sophomore (S2S) is St. Cloud State University's concurrent enrollment program. The S2S program allows eligible high school students to enroll in SCSU introductory college courses in their high schools. Courses are facilitated on a day to day basis by the local high school teacher. The integrity of the university course content is maintained through direct involvement with a SCSU faculty member.

The program is sponsored by the Center for Continuing Studies at SCSU and is an alternative to the on-campus Post-Secondary Enrollment Option Program (PSEO).

Who is Eligible?

The Minnesota State Colleges and Universities system has set the eligibility requirements for system PSEO programs. To be eligible, high school juniors must rank in the top 33 percent and seniors in the top 50 percent of their graduating class. Some specific courses may require a higher admission standard.

Admission and Registration

Students wishing to participate in the Senior to Sophomore Program need to complete the Application - Registration form found on the back side of this sheet. The form is returned to the high school counselor. After certifying student class rank, the high school forwards this form to SCSU.

Transcripts and Transferring Credits

St. Cloud State University credits earned through the Senior to Sophomore Program are approved academic credits and are transferable to other universities and colleges. Acceptance of transfer credits is always at the discretion of the receiving institution, based on their policies and guidelines. Students should check with individual institutions about their transfer guidelines.

If you are planning to attend St. Cloud State University, you do not need to transfer your credits, because they are already part of your permanent SCSU record.

If you want a copy of your transcript for your own use, or if you plan to attend a university other than SCSU after high school, you will need to request an official copy of your SCSU transcript from the Records Office. (<http://www.stcloudstate.edu/registrar/records/transcripts.asp>)

Campus Visits

Senior to Sophomore classes visit campus each year. Campus visits can include opportunities to work in a science lab or the Spatial Analysis Research Center, attend lectures by SCSU faculty, and participate in special campus events. Many campus visits include an opportunity for students to learn how to use SCSU's state of the art library. Learning how to use a university library and how to conduct academic research is an important benefit of the Senior to Sophomore Program. All S2S students have HuskyNet accounts, which allow them to access the university's library online.
