- You must take three diversity courses and one racial issues course. ECON 350 will count as one diversity course and will count in Goal 8, the course may also be substituted for one ECON 4xx upper division elective in the major.
- Students contemplating double-majoring in FIRE and ECON should be aware that this is a B.A. degree program and FIRE is a B.S. degree program. To acquire both diplomas requires 150 total credits of coursework and will take more than four years.
