

RAYMOND LARSON LEADERSHIP AWARD

The purpose of the Raymond Larson Leadership Award is to honor those Environmental and Technological Studies majors who have shown strong evidence of leadership throughout their college experience. For purposes of the award, leadership is defined as:

Demonstrated commitment to professional involvement
above and beyond normal activities.

The following guidelines are to be used for the award:

1. The award will be only for Environmental & Technological Studies majors, currently enrolled in at least 12 SCSU credits.
2. Any financial component awarded to the students can only be used for tuition reimbursement.
3. Funding for the award will be from the interest of the Raymond Larson Account. Account #5209-07203.
4. Students' participation will require nomination by any ETS faculty member.
5. Awards are normally given during Spring Semester of any year.
6. Awards may be given (or not given) in any year.
7. After being nominated by an ETS faculty member, students will be asked to fill out an application form. (See attached)
8. ETS faculty will then select 1-4 students to be interviewed by the faculty as a whole.
9. The ETS faculty will then make the final selection and the dollar amount for the award.
10. Students will only be able to receive the award one time during their college career.
11. Students selected for the award will have their names engraved on the Raymond Larson Leadership Award plaque.
