Wait list Information

Why do you have a waitlist?

The Communication Sciences and Disorders Department receives many more applications than there are spaces in the program. The CSD department admits approximately 15 to 18 Phase II full-time students each academic year. A small number of admissions may be granted to students beginning study at Phase I of the degree program.

How likely is it that I'll be admitted to the CSD degree program?

Unfortunately, it is not possible to predict what may happen with any particular person on the waitlist, or even if the waitlist will be used in any given year. We realize it can be difficult to wait, and that you may be considering other options in addition to the CSD program. We strive to complete the admissions process and have all spaces filled by April 30.

How will I know if I am on the waitlist? How will I know where I am on the list?

If you are a qualified applicant but are not offered admission, the CSD department will contact you about the opportunity to be placed on the waitlist. Contact the CSD department to find out your place on the waitlist.

When is the latest I would receive an admissions offer?

The admissions process continues until all the spots are filled. The admissions process is usually complete by April 30. It is possible, but unlikely, that an admissions offer would be made to a waitlisted student after summer session begins.

Is there anything I can do to increase my chances of being admitted?

Contact the CSD department at csd@stcloudstate.edu to inquire about ways to increase your chances of being admitted.

If I receive an offer of admission, how long do I have to decide?

For waitlisted students, the CSD department will specify a deadline to accept or reject the admissions offer.

Should I contact the admissions office to check on my status in case there have been any changes?

No, the CSD department will contact you if your admissions status changes at any point.

What should I do if my contact information changes?

If I decide to reapply to the program, when should I submit an application? Do I need to resubmit all my application materials again?

Students must reapply by the February 1 deadline for each year they wish to be admitted. It is possible you would not need to resubmit all your application materials; email Linda lekrueger@stcloudstate.edu in the School of Graduate Studies if you wish to reapply.
