Why did I get placed on a waitlist?

You were placed on a waitlist because we evaluated your application positively but we don't currently have an open position in the program. Being on the waitlist means that we are willing to accept you this year should a position in our program become available such as if an already accepted applicant decides not to attend graduate school.

How many applicants are typically on your waitlist?

Five to eight students are typically placed on our waitlist each year.

What percentage of waitlist applicants will be accepted?

Typically, over 50% of waitlist candidates are eventually accepted.

How long will I be on the waitlist before I know whether or not I am accepted?

You should be contacted with a final decision no later than the end of April. However, it is not uncommon to find out sooner.

If I am not accepted this year, will I continue to be on the waitlist next year?

No, the application evaluation process starts over each year. However, you are welcome to reapply to our program the following year if you so choose. If you are not accepted, you are welcome to contact the I-O department about how to improve your application.
