## **POLICY LANGUAGE:**

Graduate students are considered to be making satisfactory academic progress if they maintain at least a 3.00 cumulative graduate GPA and complete 66.67% (2/3) of graduate credits attempted at SCSU. Continuation in the program of study may be denied at any time during the program as a result of not maintaining satisfactory academic progress (GPA and/or course completion) at St. Cloud State University.

Graduate programs may require a higher GPA for program continuation.
