1. Campus Services Fair, Survey and Review
  - Received applications for positions Non-Traditional and MSS Rep.
  - Jeffry DeBrobander concerned about needles and their containers in the Education building- Katie will follow up with him via email.
  - Christina will fill out the email Katie received about Campus Fair and fill out survey.
2. SHIP- Tobacco Free Campus Program Grant
  - Corie is on the committee. Jenni may join the committee as a SHAC representative.
  - Grant= about \$95,000
  - There is an 18 month program that is funded by the grant from January 1, 2010-June 30, 2011. This program will help get the tobacco free campus process started.
  - There needs to be a list to show the university the process has support. The list is at approximately 1500 students as of right now.
  - St. Cloud Technical College is starting their tobacco free campus in Fall 2010.
  - Public Safety from SCSU is enforcing the policy.
  - We aren't sure how much tickets are going to be if they are issued.
3. Psychiatric Services on Campus
  - Fall semester 2009- very successful.
  - Total funding- \$32,000. Grant ends June 30<sup>th</sup>.
  - 12 hours a month on campus.
  - 1pm-5pm on Thursdays.
  - Almost every time slot was full with each time slot being an hour long. 29 patients were seen total.
  - It is \$400 dollars an hour, but free to SCSU students through the funding.
  - Corie may be presenting to the Fee Allocation Committee in February asking for approximately \$25,000-\$30,000.
4. Strides Against Breast Cancer
  - Walk was October 2009 at Lake George.
  - It's going to happen again on campus in conjunction with the Homecoming race.
  - They will promote and collaborate with each other.
  - The date is still pending due to the NCAA schedule.
5. SHS Facility
  - Buildings and grounds website has a full plan for the campus in the next 10 years.
  - The future building could possibly be the current Eastman building..
  - Preview of presentation to SHAC to Fee Allocation Committee sometime soon.
