Graduate Student Paper Prize

The best research paper presented by a graduate student at the **2009 Northern Great Plains History Conference** will receive a \$200 prize, a certificate and a banquet ticket.

To be eligible for this award, authors must be enrolled in a graduate program at an accredited college or university at the time the paper is presented.

Both a paper copy (sent by mail) of the submission and an electronic copy (as an email attachment) of the submission must be forwarded to each of the three judges listed below. The mailed copy must be postmarked no later than September 15, 2009. Late papers will not be considered. A statement from the student's advisor or other appropriate departmental official should accompany the mailed copies verifying that the student is currently enrolled.

Submitters are eligible to compete for only one graduate student prize offered in conjunction with the conference (e.g., Graduate Student Paper Prize or Society for Military History Prize).
