Ronald J. Moulton is completing his first year as director of the SCSU Marching Huskies at St. Cloud State University. Moulton was the Director of Instrumental Music in Princeton, Minnesota at the high school since 1970. He now manages his own business and is teaching music at Princeton Middle School.

The SCSU Marching Huskies play a wide variety of great music, ranging from popular tunes and swingin' jazz to the dramatic power of the best drum corps arrangements. Our talented group of flag and rifle twirlers, known as the colorguard, provide beautifully choreographed movement while one of the best college drumlines in the Midwest supplies a powerful marching beat.
