The Conductor

Richard K. Hansen is director of bands and assistant professor of music at St. Cloud State University, where he conducts the Concert/Chamber Band and administers the University and Marching Bands. Prior to his position at St. Cloud, Hansen was the director of instrumental music at Hawley, Minnesota. He holds a B. A. degree in music education from Sioux Falls College, a M.A. degree in musicology from the University of Minnesota, and is presently pursuing a Ph.D. in musicology at the University of Minnesota.

In addition to his directing and conducting duties, Mr. Hansen teaches graduate courses in conducting and literature, and he is the author of the recently approved master's degree in conducting and literature at St. Cloud State University. Mr. Hansen has a keen interest in the research of wind literature and has presented papers for the International Society for the Research and Promotion of Wind Music, the College Band Directors National Association and the Minnesota Music Educators Association. He is currently preparing a monograph on Josef Gungl and mid-nineteenth century band music for the International Society. Mr. Hansen is active as a guest conductor/clinician, having served over 100 school festivals, clinics, and concerts, since coming to St. Cloud State six years ago.

The Marching Band Director

Jeffrey M. Wood is currently serving in his first year as director of the Marching Huskies organization. Mr. Wood brings a variety of professional, school and community teaching and performance experience to his new position. Since 1984, Mr. Wood has been an instructor for the large American popular music classes at SCSU and assisted with the band and jazz programs. Mr. Wood has instructed several area high school marching band programs and provided private lessons in those school programs. He is also well-known for his performances and arrangements with The Greystone Rockers and Zsaturday Jazz Band. Mr. Wood earned a B.A. degree in music and a B.S. degree in music education from St. Cloud State University and is enrolled in the master's degree in conducting and literature program at St. Cloud State.
