With course offerings in theory, composition, counterpoint, jazz harmony and arranging, orchestration and numerous courses in electroacoustic music and new media, SCSU students graduate prepared to pursue graduate studies or a career in music creation.

In addition to our award-winning faculty, the Music Department hosts numerous guest artists and master classes with world-class musicians and composers. Students have many opportunities to hear their compositions performed, from large ensemble to solo works to multimedia performance.

Our newest initiative is the establishment of advanced multimedia computer facilities, located in the Performing Arts Center and in Kiehle Visual Arts Center. These labs feature a variety of software programs, including ProTools, Max/MSP/Jitter, Reaktor, Peak and numerous visual art software programs. The ElectroAcoustic and New Media Studio (EANMS)--located in the Performing Arts Center--features a two channel editing station and a 5.1 surround sound system for multichannel audio diffusion. EANMS is located next to a multipurpose room suitable for the development, rehearsal and presentation of fixed-media and interactive multichannel ElectroAcoustic and Multimedia works of art.
