<b>Course</b>	<b>ED 300: Introduction to Middle Level and High School Education</b>
<b>Experience Type</b>	High school ( <i>or middle school</i> ) classrooms (Communication Arts & Literature, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Technology Ed.) and K–12 subjects (Art, ESL, Foreign Languages, Music, Physical Ed, and Info Media)
<b>Duration, Frequency, and Approximate Dates</b>	20 hours total: Begin as soon as placement is accepted.  Exact schedule to be arranged by the student and cooperating teacher.
<b>Year at SCSU</b>	Varies from freshman to 5 <sup>th</sup> year students, typically sophomore or junior.
<b>Stage in Education Program</b>	A foundational course for the secondary program as well as exploring teaching as a career.
<b>Expectations of Student:</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. One-on-One teaching</li> <li>2. Teaching small groups</li> <li>3. Whole class teaching</li> <li>4. Assist with classroom routines</li> </ol>
<b>Teacher Involvement</b>	Guide, model, and complete final evaluation form and rubric.
<b>Supervision</b>	No direct supervision from SCSU, but faculty member in charge is available by email or phone.
