

Collaborative master's program offered in Public Safety Executive Leadership

SCSU is spearheading the development of a unique opportunity to earn a Public Safety Executive Leadership Master's degree.

The program will focus on the management, critical thinking and human resource skills necessary for public safety leaders in emergency services, corrections, the courts systems, disaster services, fire services, law enforcement, private security and school safety, with a special focus on creative and cost-efficient solutions for long-standing public safety problems.

The program will be offered via the traditional classroom, interactive television, weekend learning packages and online. This flexible program will allow working professionals to earn a master's degree without leaving their jobs for traditional coursework and residency.

Other universities involved in developing the program include Bemidji State University, Metropolitan State University, Minnesota State University-Mankato, and Winona State University.
