

Student station awarded \$65,000

KVSC-FM is 1 of 10 in country to get grant from program

KVSC-FM, the student radio station at St. Cloud State University, has been awarded a \$65,000 public broadcasting grant.

It is one of 10 radio stations in the country to receive a grant from the Corporation for Public Broadcasting Community Service Grant Program.

The station must use 25 percent on national programming and is free to use the rest as it chooses.

The station has plans for a Web redesign, a marketing plan and technical upgrades that might be uses for the money, station manager Jo McMullen-Boyer said.

To qualify for the grant, stations must offer programming that serves the educational, information and cultural needs of the community and have significant local programming while being professionally equipped for quality broadcasting.
