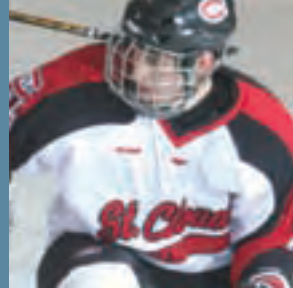

STUDENT PROFILE BY COLLEGE BASED ON FIRST MAJOR: FALL 2006 FINAL HEADCOUNT

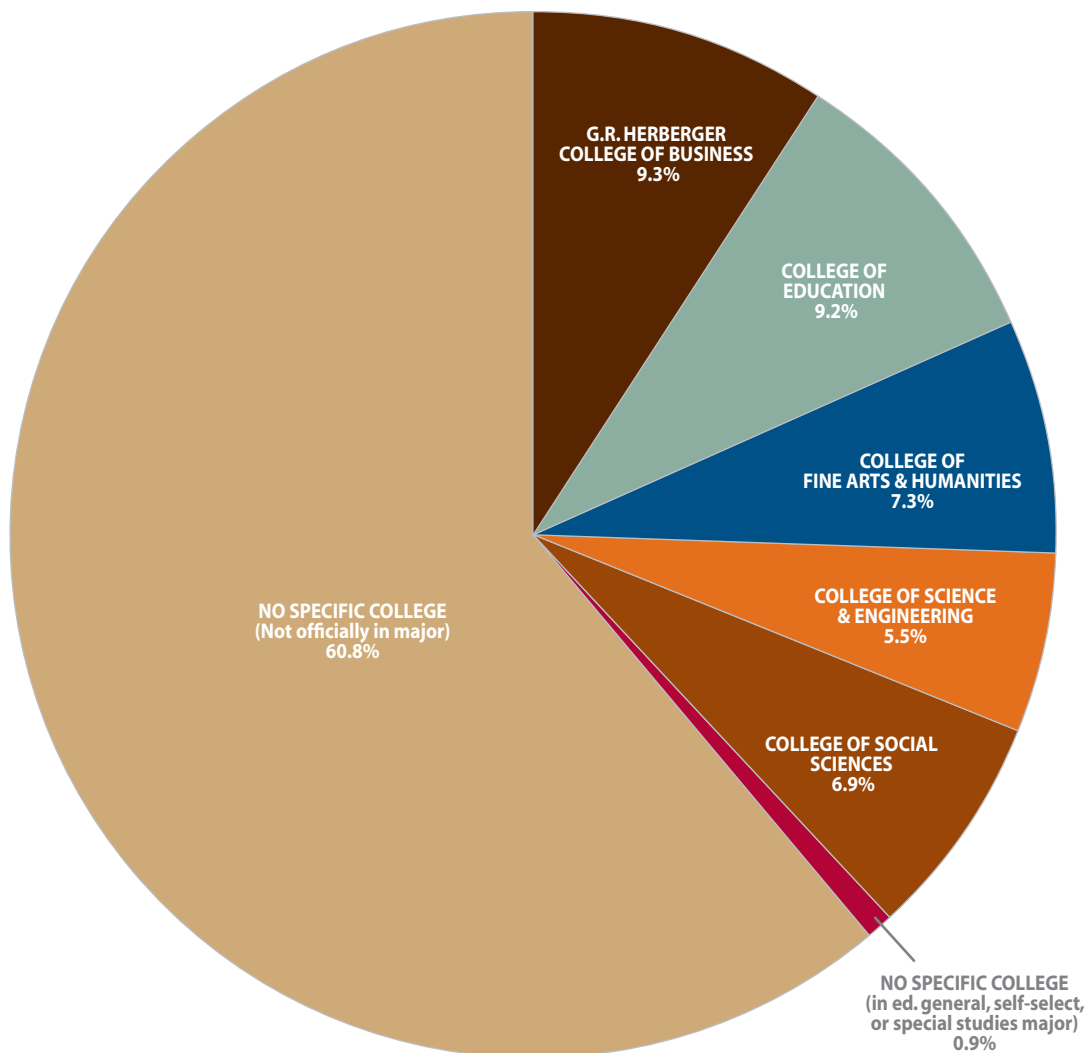

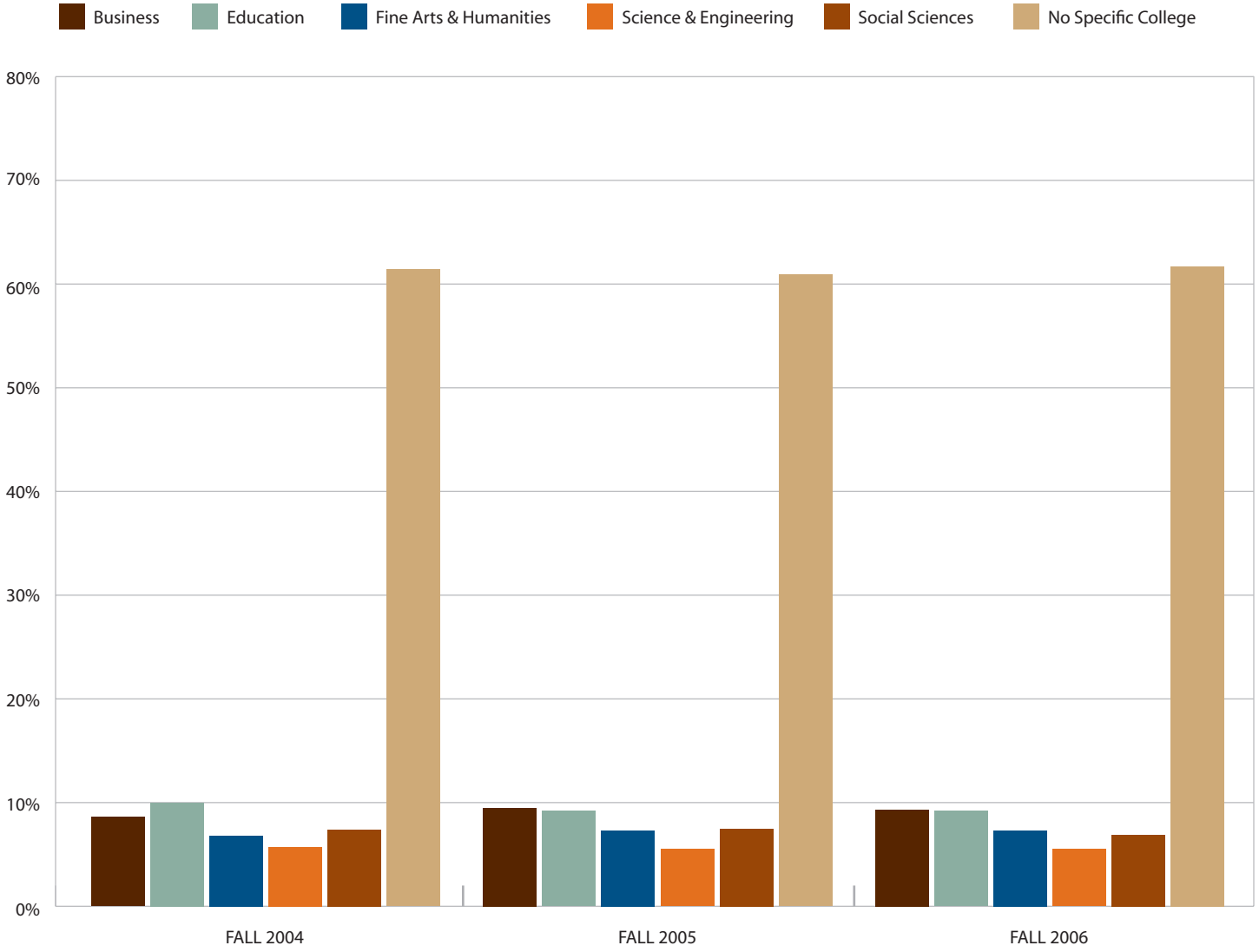

PERCENTAGE OF FIRST MAJORS BY COLLEGE*

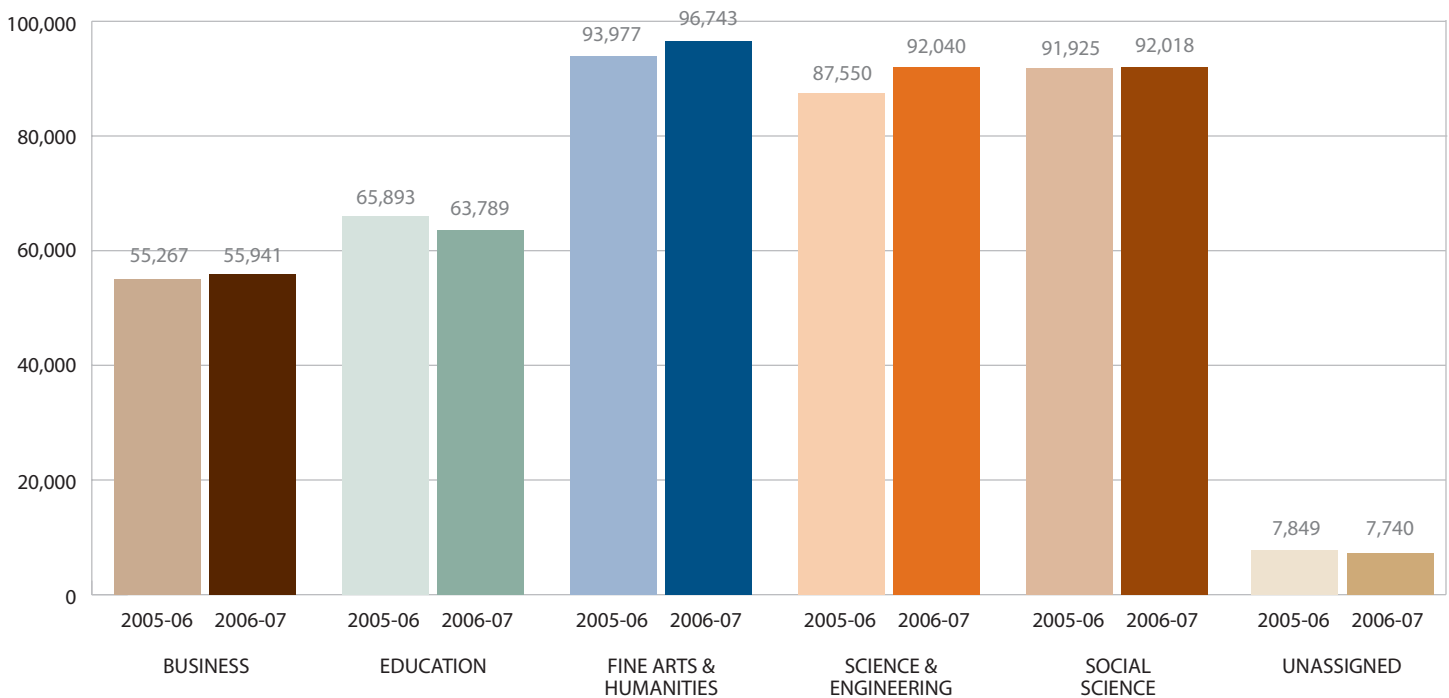

HEADCOUNT ENROLLMENT BY LEVEL

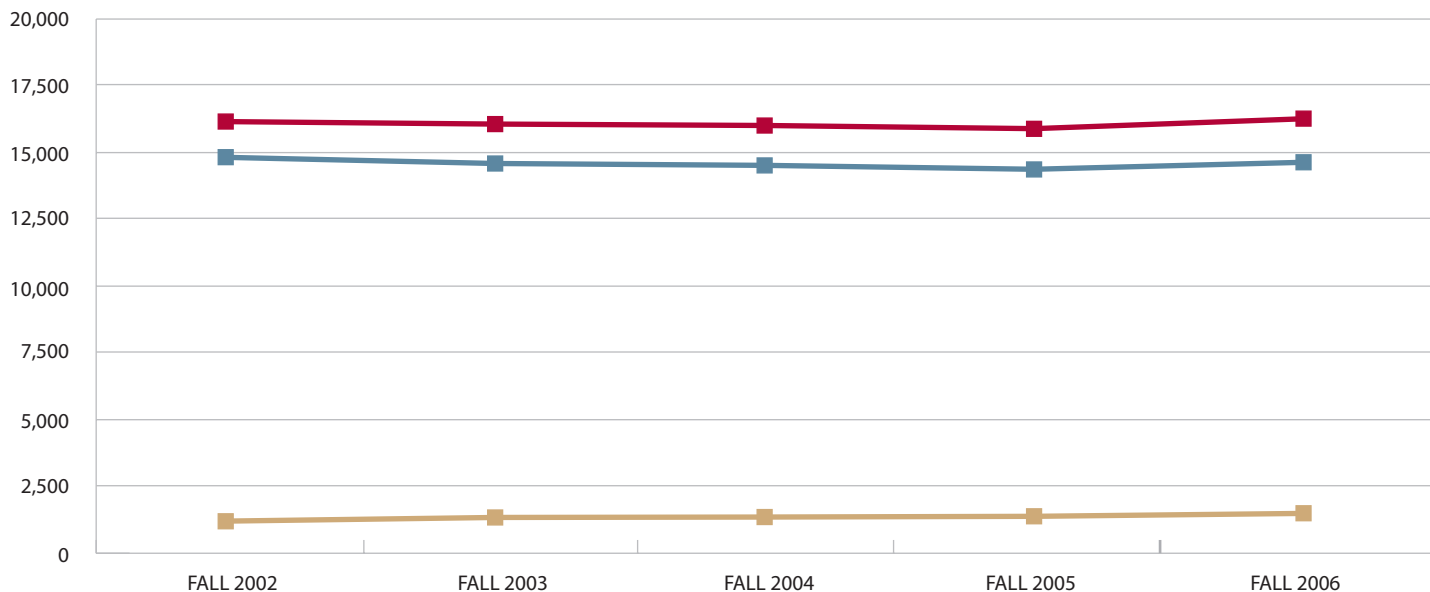

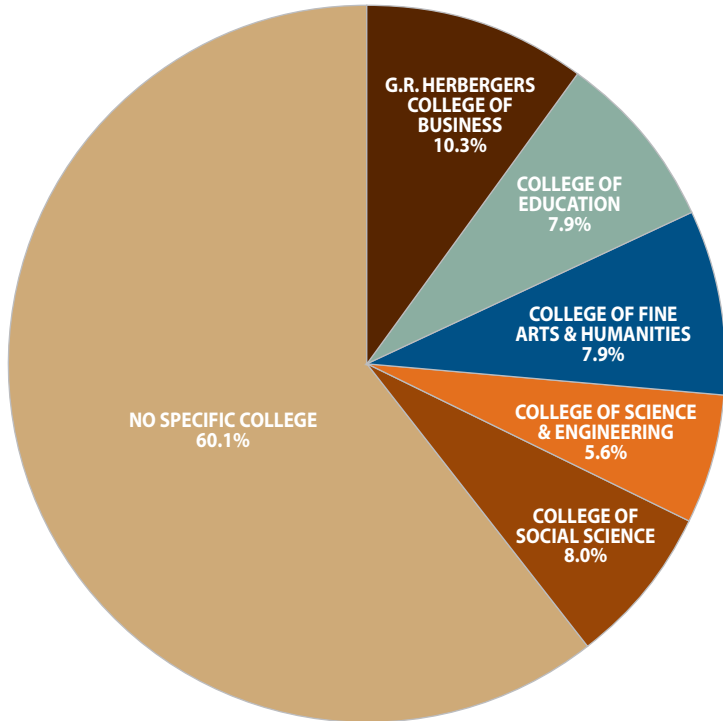

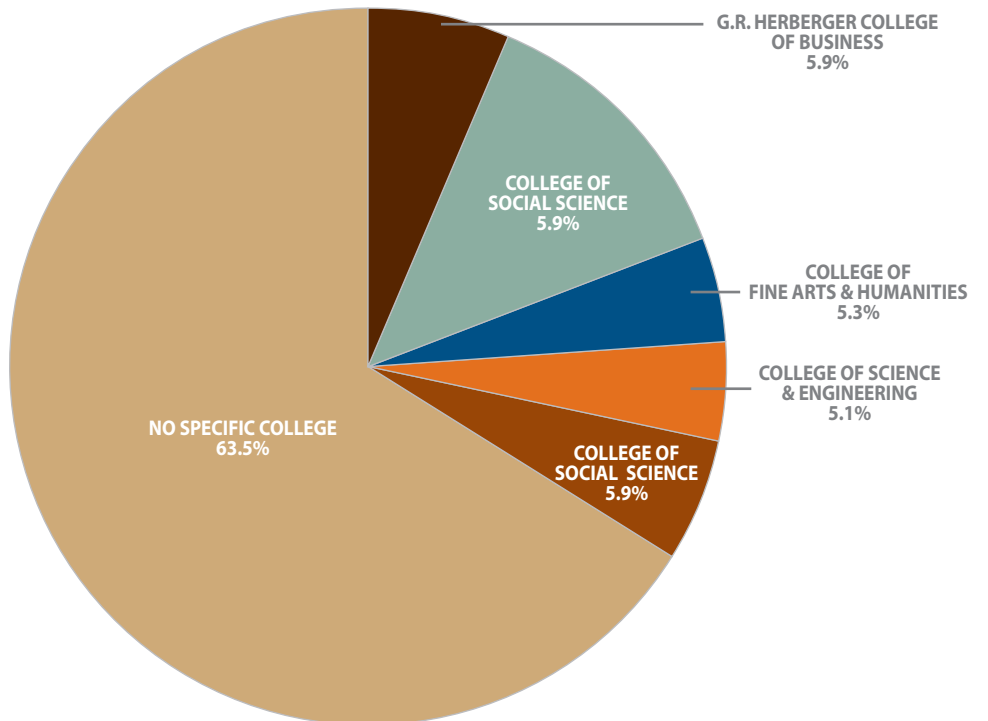

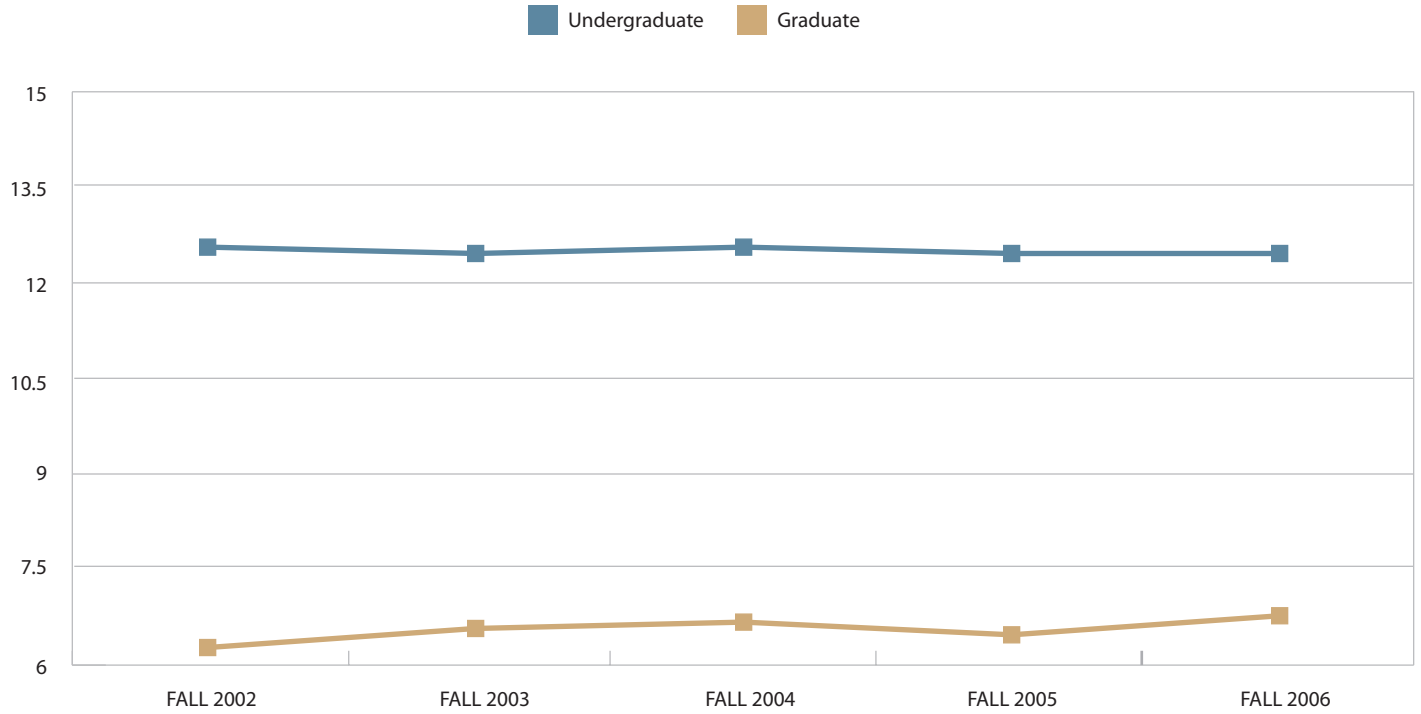
FALL 2006 FULL-TIME

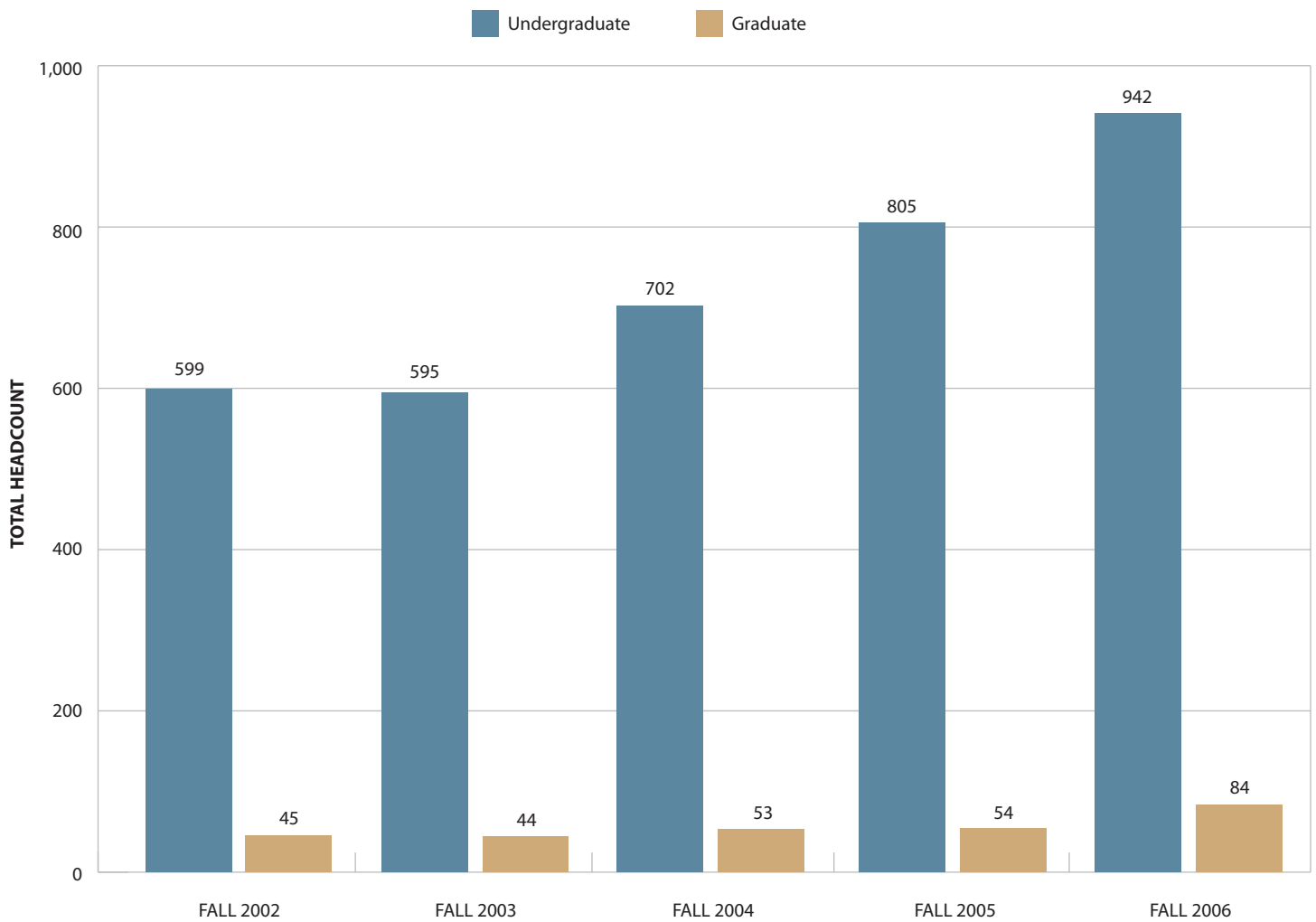

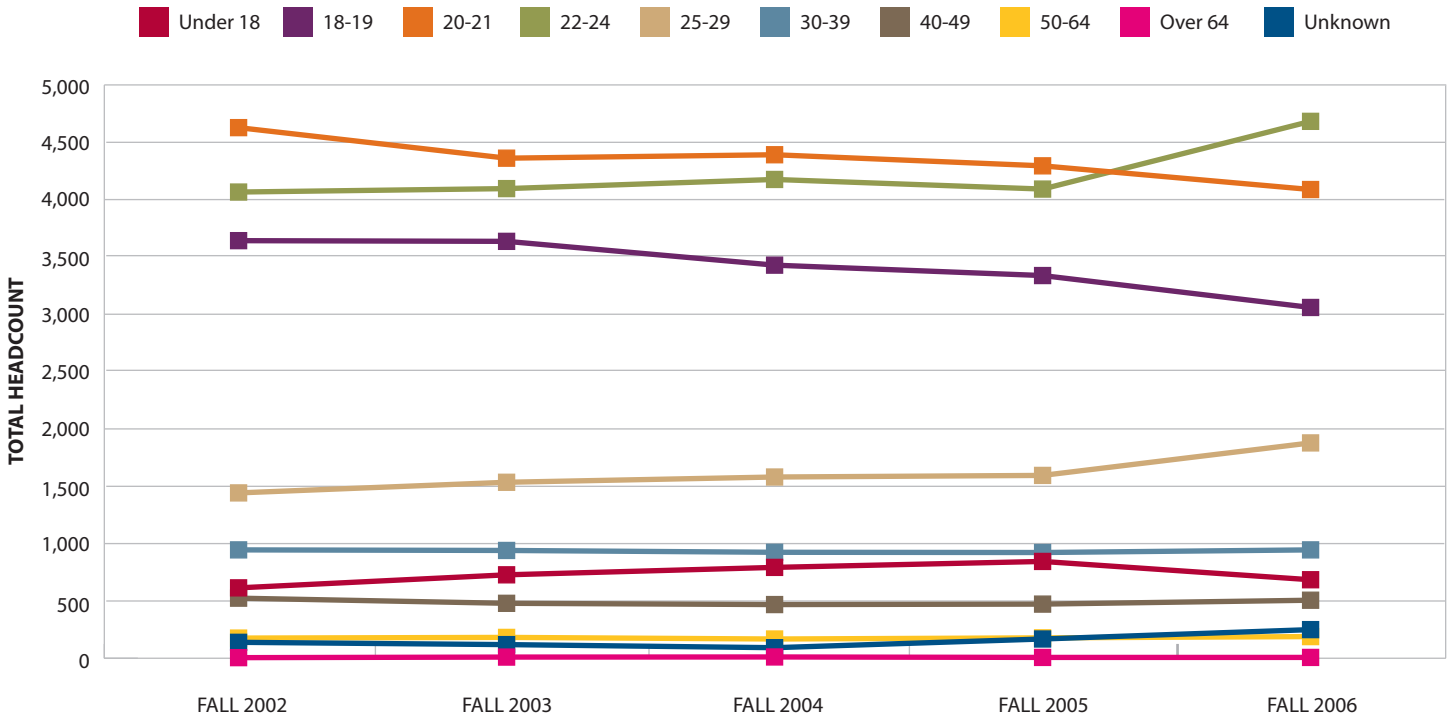

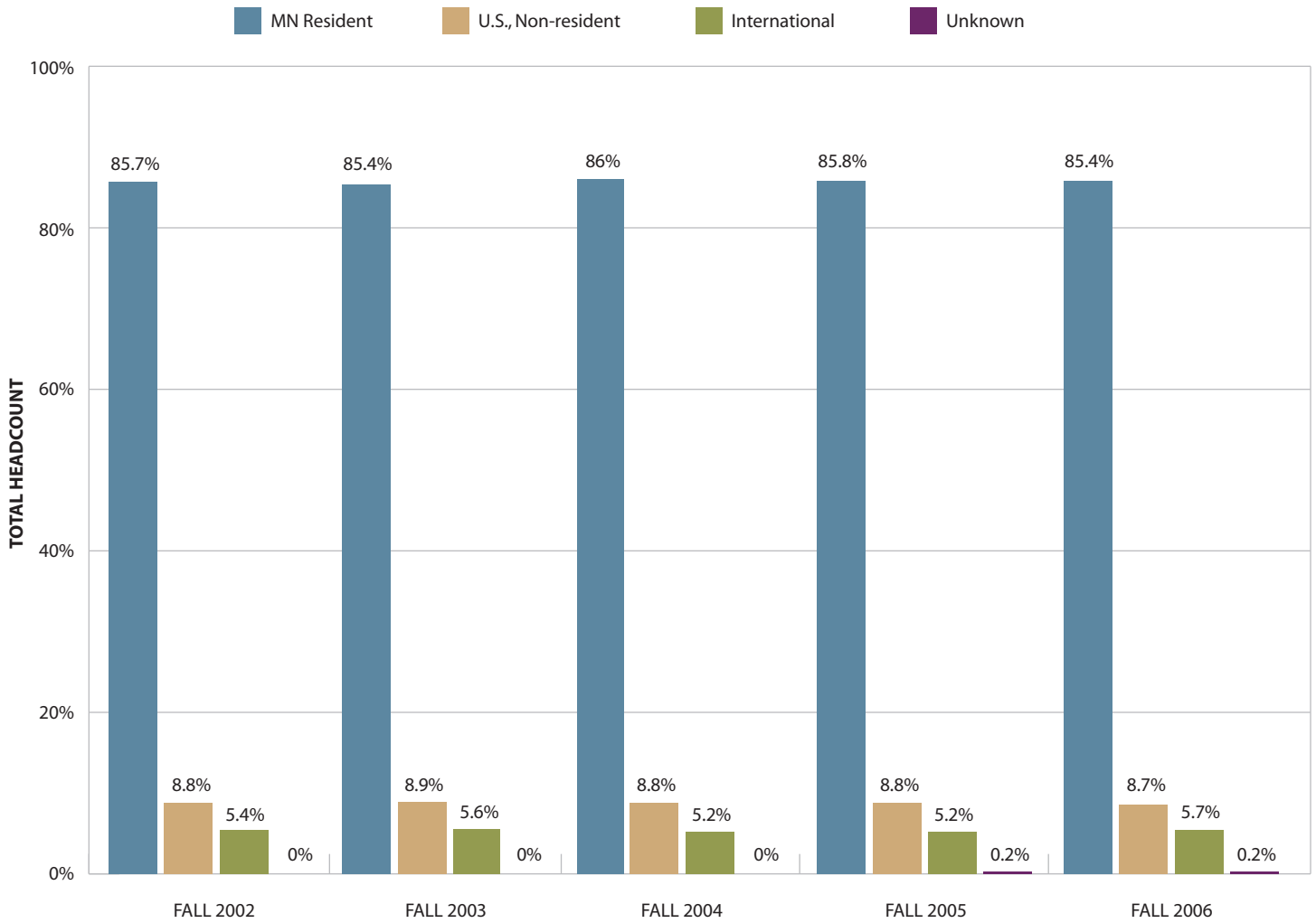
FINAL TOTAL ENROLLMENT BY AGE

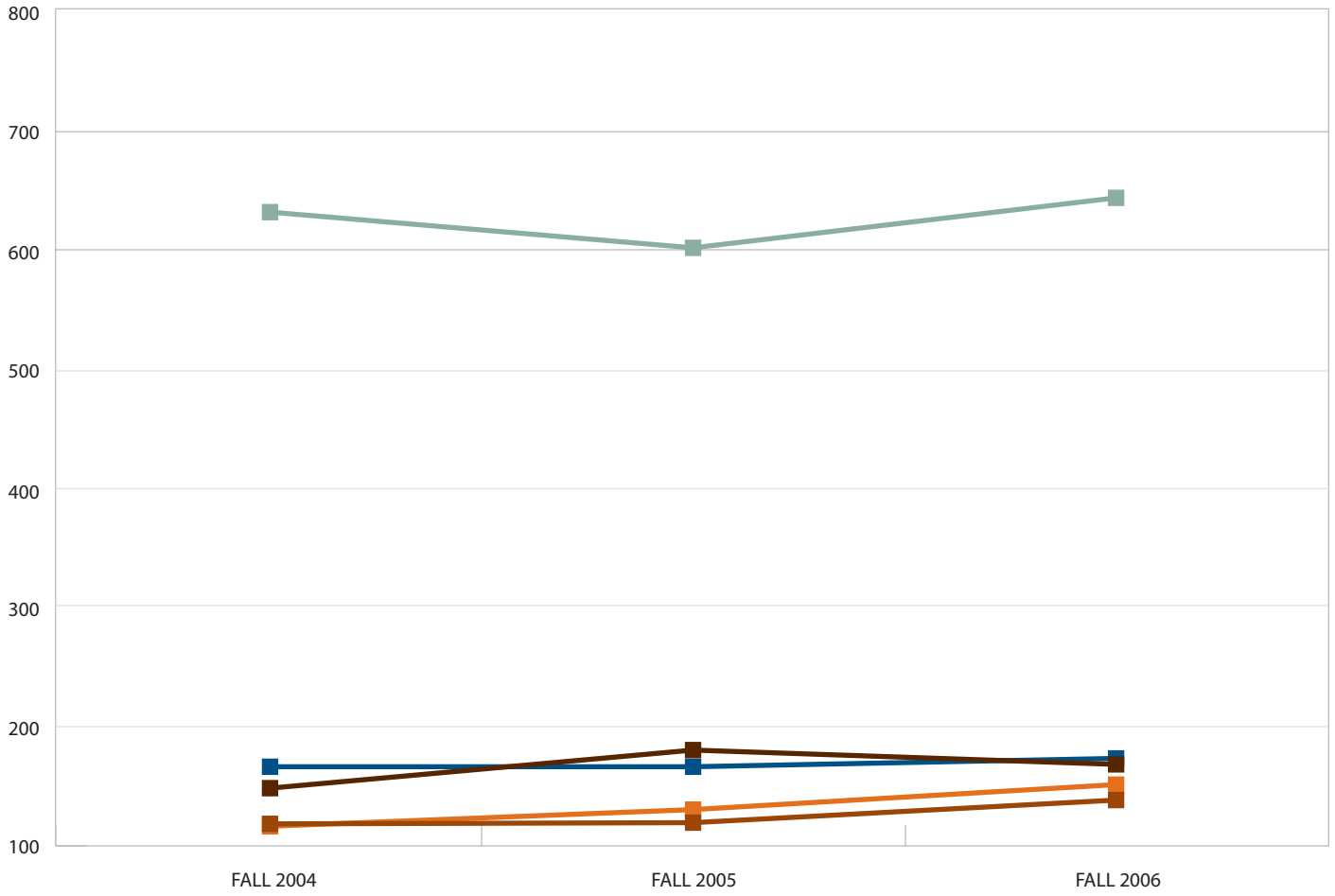

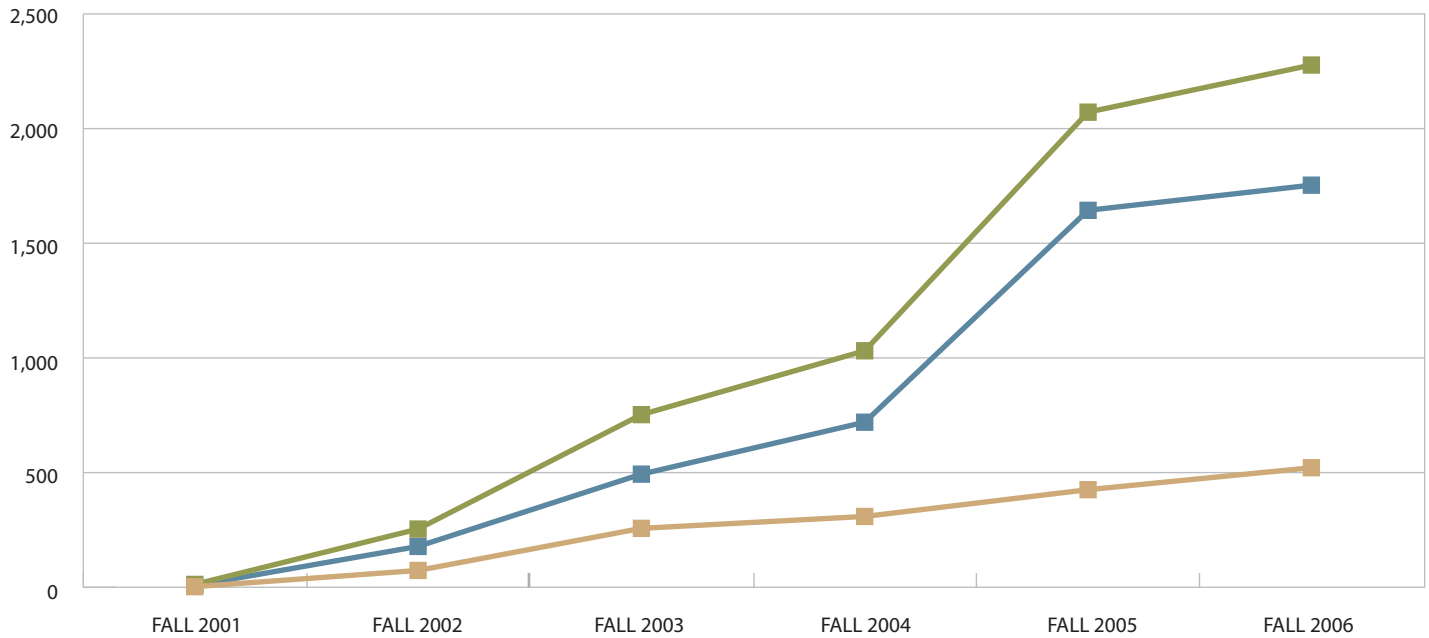

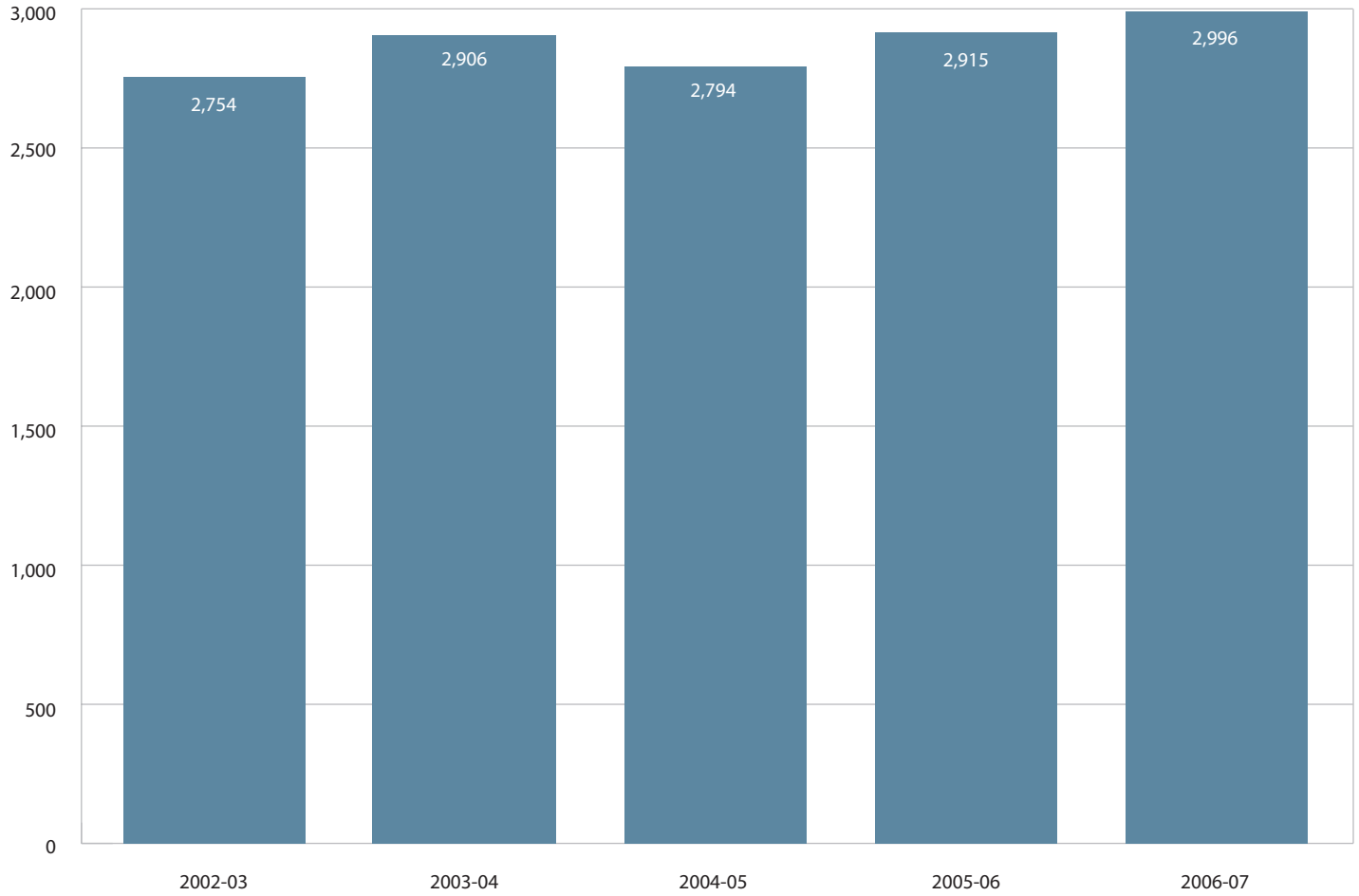

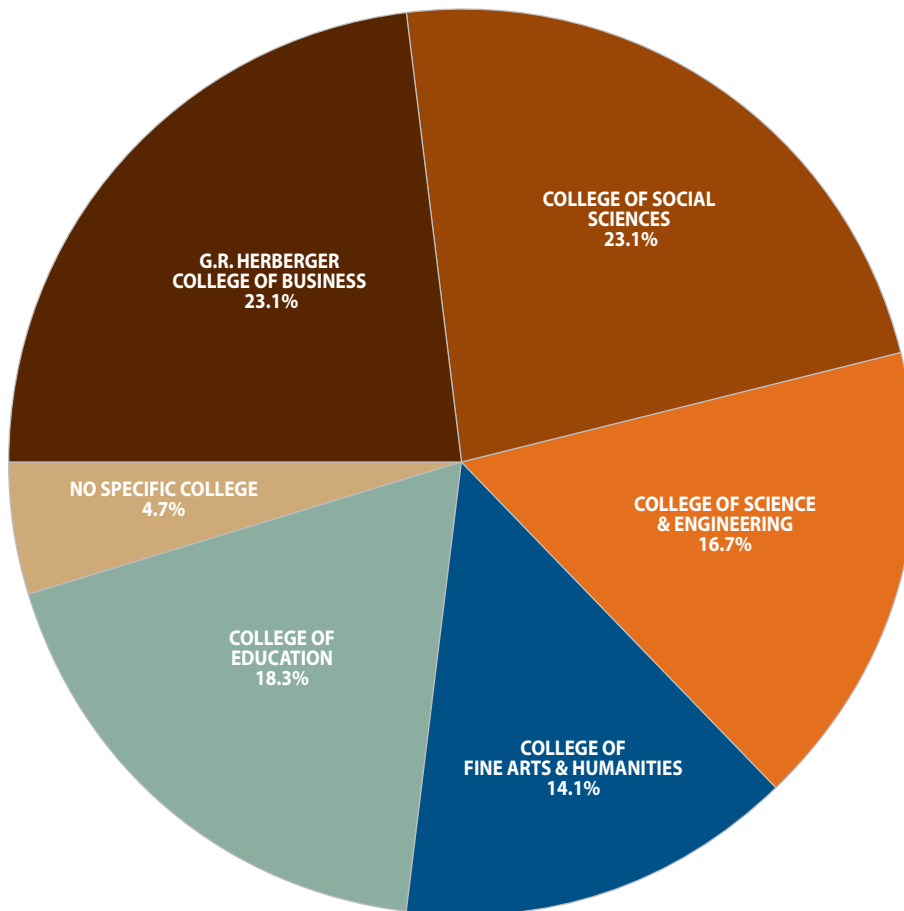
TOTAL ANNUAL DEGREES AWARDED*



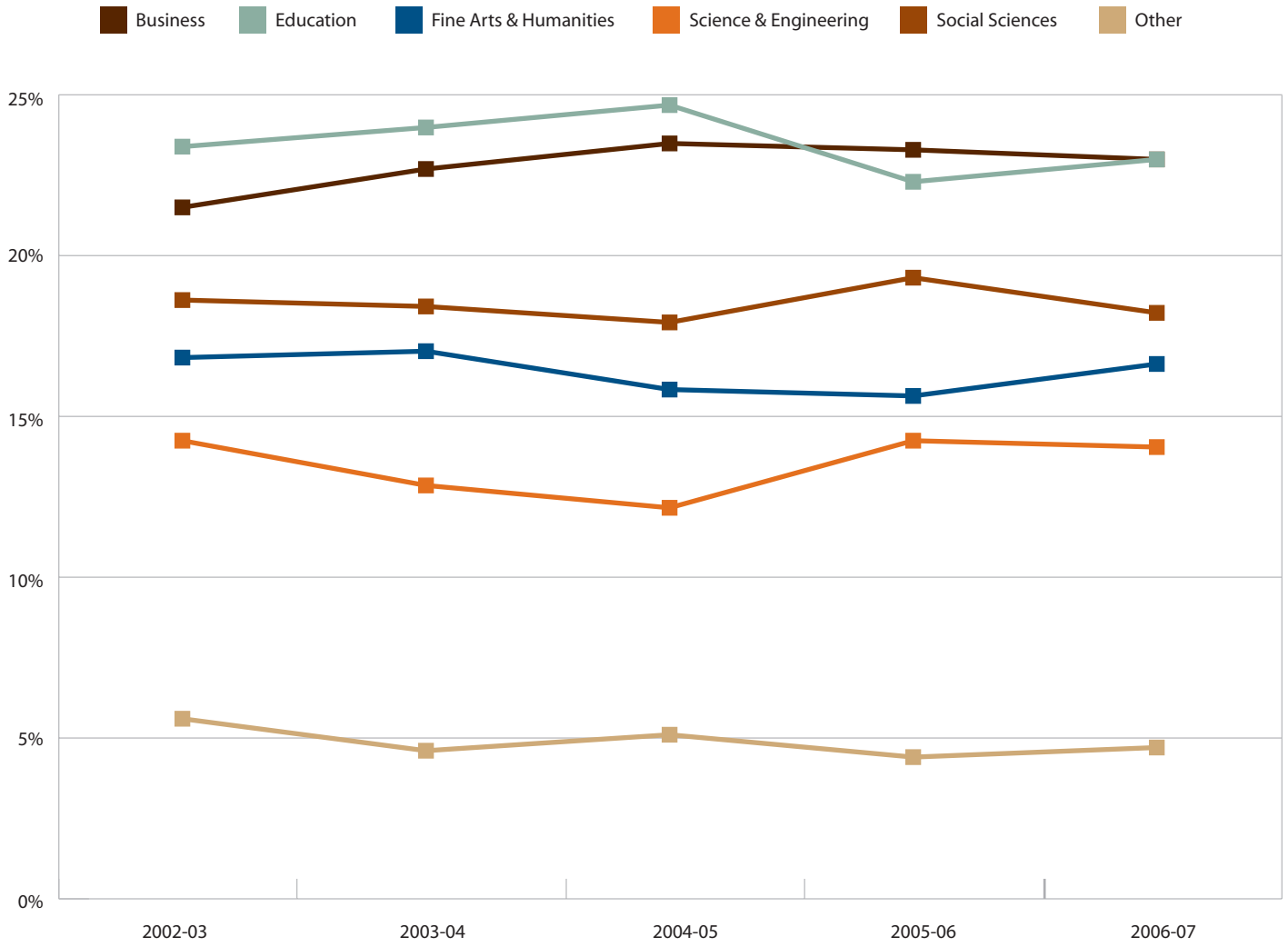

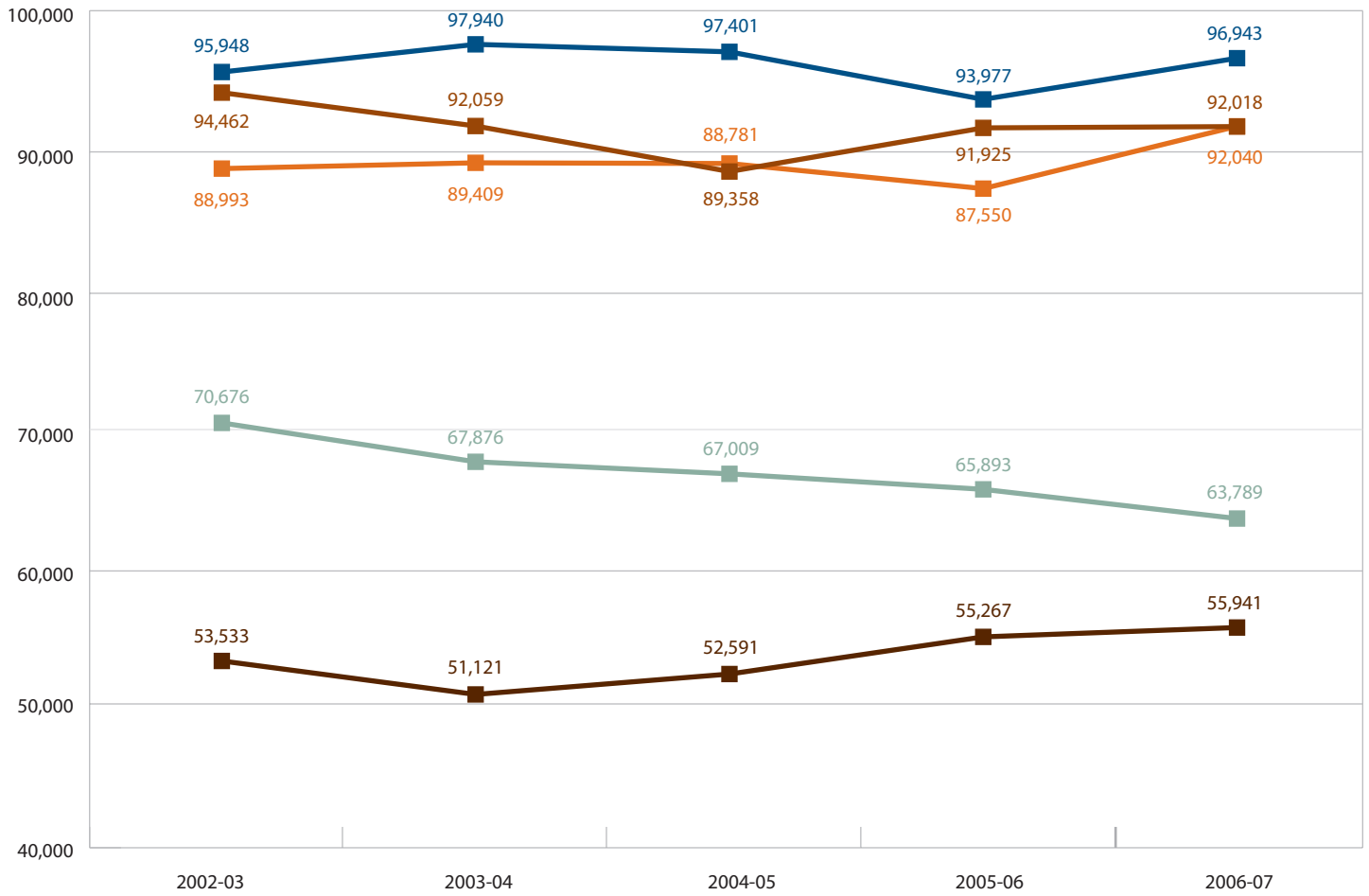


2002-07 DEGREES AWARDED TREND BY COLLEGE

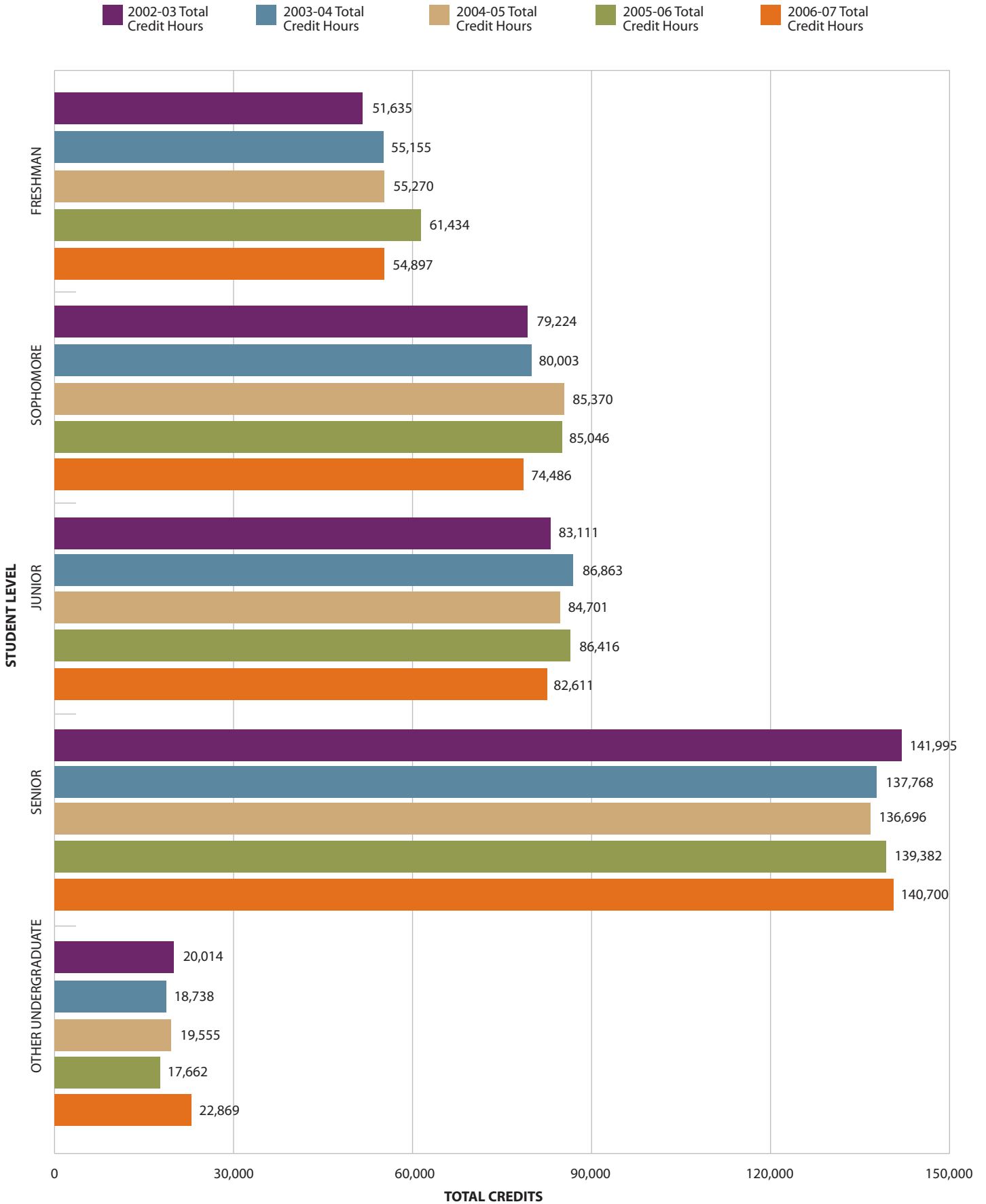


2002-07 CREDITS BY COLLEGE

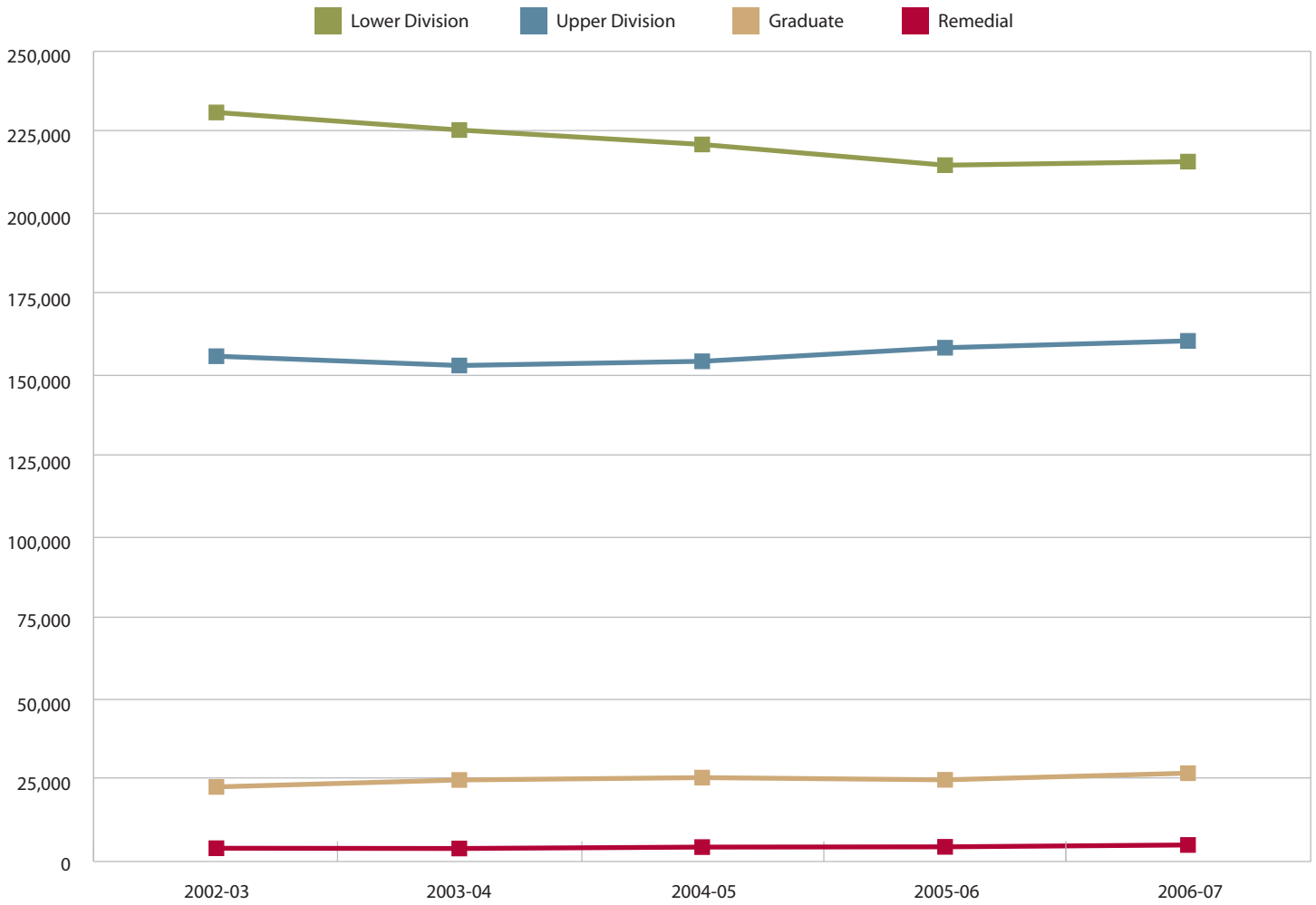


2002-07 UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT CREDIT HOURS BY CLASS LEVEL
