General Spring Break Housing Information:

Residence Halls will be closing for Spring Break on Friday, March 5 at 5:00 pm. The Halls will re-open on Sunday, March 14 at 1 p.m. Residents interested in staying on campus during the break period need to complete a Break Housing Registration form. These will be available at the front desks of each Residence Hall, on-line at the SCSU Res Life website www.stcloudstate.edu/reslife and at the Department of Residential Life office in Carol Hall.

Residents may apply to stay in Stateview Apartments, Benton Hall, Hill-Case Hall, Sherburne Hall and Lawrence Hall. All other residence halls will be closed during break periods.

Residents residing in buildings on campus that are not open during break periods and requesting break housing must receive permission from residents living in an eligible building to stay for the break period. All roommates must provide permission and one roommate must provide keys to the apartment or room. No more than assigned capacity +1 students may reside in a room during the break (e.g. a double room can house no more than 3 students over the break period).

Residents applying for break housing must indicate the reason housing is required for the break period. Reasons generally are a result of a special circumstance, University commitment such as organized athletics, International Students, students living out of state or a long distance from home, working at a nearby job, etc. Please note that **no meals** will be provided for students during these breaks. It is the student's responsibility to find alternate arrangements either off campus or with a friend who lives in one of the buildings which will house students over break periods.

If you plan to stay in your hall at any time during the Spring Break period, you must sign up at your residence hall's front desk. There is currently no charge for Spring Break housing, but residents who intend to stay must pre-register for safety and security purposes. The deadline to sign up for Spring Break housing is Monday, March 1, 2010.

We will maintain all safety and security procedures throughout the break. Night Security Staff will be checking IDs beginning at 7 p.m. each evening and Residential Life Staff will conduct regular safety rounds throughout the break period. Front desk services will be available in the designated break housing halls. However, there will be no U.S. Mail pick up during the break period.

If you are around during Spring Break and notice any suspicious activity in the residence halls, please contact a Residential Life staff member or Public Safety immediately. As always, you play a primary role

in contributing to a safe and secure environment on campus. On behalf of the entire Residential Life Staff, we hope you have a safe and enjoyable Spring Break!
