Admission REQUIREMENTS

Students are eligible for admission as transfer students if they have earned 12 or more college-level credits at a regionally accredited college-level institution. Transfer credit will not be granted for remedial or non-degree credit as indicated by the sending institution. Applicants should have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. All credits earned with a "C" or higher grade are considered for credit transfer. Students with fewer than 12 transferrable college-level credits will need to provide their high school transcripts and ACT or SAT scores with their application.

Admission to a major program is a separate process; requirements vary. Higher grade point averages and/or specific course requirements may apply.

Post Secondary Enrollment Option (PSEO) credits or any high school student that is completing college credits cannot be counted in the 12 credits. PSEO students should apply as freshmen regardless of the number of college credits completed.

HOW WILL MY COURSES TRANSFER TO ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY?

This is a great way to find out how courses will transfer into St. Cloud State University! If your college/university is not listed, please contact the Office of Admissions for further information on how your courses will transfer.

In general, courses that are completed with a "C" or better from colleges that are accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges or other regional accrediting agencies will transfer into St. Cloud State University.

An official evaluation of credits will be completed once you've been formally admitted to the university.

HOW TO

Apply

Verify

that you meet our admission guidelines.

Submit your application for admission and your \$20 application fee.

Request all transcripts (even if you withdrew) to be sent to St. Cloud State University. If you have attended or are currently attending one or more MnSCU institutions, your official transcripts can be electronically retrieved by St. Cloud State University.



WHAT KIND OF SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE AT ST. CLOUD STATE UNIVERSITY?

St Cloud State University awards a limited number of scholarships to incoming transfer students with strong academic credentials. Transfer students should demonstrate achievement with a cumulative GPA of at least 3.5 on a 4.0 scale. Phi Theta Kappa and Alumni Scholarships are also available. To be considered for **all Transfer Scholarships (including PTK and Alumni)**, students must complete a Transfer Student Scholarship Application. Transfer Scholarships are awarded Fall Semester.

NON-RESIDENT TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

Non-Resident Tuition Scholarships are awarded to students who do not otherwise qualify for in-state or reciprocity tuition. Recipients pay the equivalent of in-state tuition. Transfer applicants must provide evidence of a 3.0 GPA in all college work (minimum of 24 transferrable credits) to qualify.

ADVISING AND REGISTRATION DAYS

Students will receive information about the transfer advising and registration process after they have been formally admitted to the University. This process will connect new transfer students with an advisor within their major to help identify what courses to register for, as well as to discuss how courses will transfer into their major program.

HOW DO I RECEIVE PRIORITY REGISTRATION?

We recommend transfer students apply early. Priority registration allows you to register with our current St. Cloud State University students. This will provide the smooth transition that is essential to having a successful start at St. Cloud State University.

Application Timeline

Fall Semester.....March 15
Spring Semester.....October 15
