What are CPCs?

Crisis pregnancy centers (CPCs) are **anti-abortion organizations** designed to **misinform** patients about abortion, birth control, and other reproductive health services.

How CPCs HARM

- CPCs often lie about pregnancy development and gestation to confuse you about your options.
- CPCs target low-income, vulnerable, and marginalized communities who lack alternative resources.
- Many CPCs provide "abortion reversal pills" which are not supported by any accredited research
- Most of these facilities aren't licensed medical clinics, so they aren't required to follow H.I.P.A.A. confidentiality laws - meaning your private health information could be shared without your knowledge or consent.
- CPCs often use sexist messaging and shame people for their sexual and reproductive choices
- Some CPCs coerce clients to pray with them when receiving services

How to spot CPCs

- CPCs often use the tagline:
 "Pregnant and alone?" or
 "Pregnant and need help?"
- CPCs use free pregnancy tests and ultrasounds to lure people into their space.
- CPCs use **religious messaging** and/or require education groups before providing services and resources.
- Have **misleading names**, such as: "Women's Care Center" or "Pregnancy Resource Center"
