# APPLICATION PROCEDURE

*NOTE: LATE OR INCOMPLETE PACKETS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.*

**By March 1, request two current letters of recommendation.**

Only complete scholarship application packets will be considered for awards. Therefore, it is important that you follow these instructions:

✓	Apply for scholarships for which you meet the criteria (e.g., GPA, age, class status, community service, etc.). Be sure to answer all of the questions on the application.
✓	Request two <u>current</u> letters of recommendation to be sent to you by <b>March 16</b> (one letter should be from a faculty member, unless you have been out of school for a long period of time). Only one letter from each person is necessary to apply for multiple scholarships.
✓	Submit a copy of the transcript from your most recent institution. (Previous transcripts can be submitted if you need to explain a deficient GPA.) <u>Transcripts must show your name and the name of the institution.</u>
✓	Write a letter/essay (2-4 pages) to the scholarship committee addressing the following: - Describe your educational plan and goals, as well as your future career plans. - Discuss your financial needs and circumstances. - Outline obstacles and barriers that have affected your educational pursuits, thus far.
