Perceptive Content, our document imaging solution formerly called ImageNow, is being upgraded this July. #### **IT Security Tip**

IT security issues have been making international headlines, and it's important that individuals take precautions to protect themselves. Please heed the following tips to better protect yourself from cyber-criminals:

- Proactively update software
- Do not click on links in emails you are not familiar with
- Do not store critical files on your local device (work computer), store on X: drive or One Drive

- Backup critical files at home regularly
- Change passwords frequently
- Do not use the same password for multiple accounts
