Assistive Technology Software

Workstations with upgraded assistive technology are now available in the Miller Center through a partnership between ITS, the University Library and Student Accessibility Services. Assistive technologies include:

- Jaws and Zoomtext, to assist students who are blind or low vision
- Dragon Naturally Speaking, a dictation tool for students who may have mobility or written language struggles
- Read & Write, a literacy software with a variety of tools to assist students in listening to electronic material in audio along with organizational and writing tools

This summer, St. Cloud State University is moving to Minnesota State's Office 365 Shared Tenant, a system-wide effort to combine Microsoft features and services. Primary benefits include:

- Enhanced collaboration across the Minnesota State System
