IT Security Tip: Microsoft Teams Privacy and Maintenance



Microsoft Teams is an online workspace designed for collaboration. Because of the shared nature of this service, it is important for Team Owners to ensure appropriate levels of privacy and maintenance. We generally recommend having a private Team versus a public Team, and also strongly encourage Team Owners to regularly manage members of their Teams to ensure only those who should have access to the team are authorized to do so.
