IT Security Tip: Protect Your Personal Files from Ransomware



Ransomware has been such a growing issue in cybersecurity for the last few years that the <u>U.S. Department of Justice</u> announced that ransomware attacks are going to get similar priority as terrorism. These increased efforts led to an effective response to the <u>Colonial Pipeline</u> ransomware attack, including the recovery of millions of dollars.

You can protect your personal files from ransomware with Microsoft OneDrive's <u>ransomware detection and recovery</u>, included with either Microsoft 365 Family or Personal plans.

IT Support Tip: Accessing Network Folders on Windows 10



When using shortcuts to access departmental network folders on a Windows 10 device, select the "This PC" option instead of selecting "Network". If you select "Network", you will get a message that network discovery is turned off. If you continue to have issues, see the Missing Network Drives knowledge base article for troubleshooting instructions.
