These changes are a part of Minnesota State's NextGen project, a technology modernization initiative that creates pathways and opportunities to implement next generation technology across all 33 colleges and universities.

#### IT Security Tip: Keep Applications Updated



"End-of-life" and "end-of-support" are terms that indicate a product, operating system or application will no longer be supported by the manufacturer or vendor. Unsupported devices or software can become vulnerable to cyberattacks that may not be prevented by traditional security measures like antivirus software. You can find out if your devices and software are still receiving support online through a search on the endoflife.date website.

Over 40 years ago, on August 1st, 1981, MTV (Music Television) launched on cable TV as a 24-hour platform for music videos. The first video played on MTV was the symbolically appropriate "Video Killed the Radio Star" by the Buggles. MTV had an immediate impact on the music industry and was an iconic symbol of the technology-driven 1980's.
