Diversity of Placements

Four Areas of Diversity using state of MN district averages for 2012*:

- 1. Free and Reduced Lunch population (above or = to 40%)

 (MN State average at that time was 37%. 40% is the requirement for a school/district to qualify for additional federal grants so this % was chosen.)
- 2. Ethnicity (below or = to 74% white)
- 3. Limited English Proficiency (above or = to 8%)
- 4. Students with Special Needs (above or = to 15%)

Diversity in Field and Clinical Placements will be as follows:

- **3 Highly Diverse Placement**: the population of students is above or equal to the state average in 2 or more of the above defined areas
- **2 Diverse Placement:** the population of students is above or equal to the state average in 1 of the defined areas
- 1 Not Diverse: all other placements fall into this third category
